After reaching the village, volunteers met the high school teachers and identified the places to do Plantation activity in School. Divided the Volunteers into groups and conducted the events. A group planted saplings in the premises of the school and geo-tagged the plants using kobo-collect app. Our team planted nearly 200 saplings.

For this our students used MAPS.ME app. Due to this program the information of the important places of that village became available so those who visits the place for first time can easily identify the addresses in the village. We planned an event of GIS mapping. A geographic information system (GIS) is a system designed to capture, store, manipulate, analyze, manage, and present all types of geographical data. The key word to this technology is Geography – this means that some portion of the data is spatial. In other words, data that is in some way referenced to locations on the earth. We have mapped the main centers and places like temples, ponds, schools, anganwadi centers, water plants, ration depots, milk booths, churches and shops of the village. All the locations were uploaded in street maps. For this our students used MAPS.ME app. Due to this program the information of the important places of that village became







available. so those who visits the place for first time can easily identify the addresses in the village. This information is also helpful for surveys etc...

A vibrant Grama Sabha is essential for the effective functioning of Village Panchayats by promoting transparency and accountability in administration, enhancing public participation in the planning and implementation of schemes and in the choice of beneficiaries, and paving the way for social audit. The Government have ordered the conduct of Grama Sabha meetings a minimum of four times a year. So we insisted villagers to make use of it and get their requirements done.

Afternoon of the second day About 20 volunteers divided into sub groups and went in to the streets, lanes and by lanes of the village. Few groups organized a cleanliness drive








Swatch Bharat by selecting a street nearby the panchayat office. Volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed dust heaps.

BLOOD GROUPING

From 11:00 clock we started the blood group identification program we invited three Bio Technology (BT) students to do the job.



The <u>grouping</u> is very important when it comes to having a blood transfusion. If blood is given to a patient that has a blood type that is incompatible with the blood type of the blood that the patient receives, it can cause intravenous clumping in the patient's blood which can be fatal.

The patient's body can start producing antibodies that attack the antigens on the blood cells in the blood that was given to the patient.

We organized blood grouping in the ZPH school for students and we had given an identity card so that they will never forget.

HEMOGLOBIN TEST

A hemoglobin test measures the amount of hemoglobin in your blood. Hemoglobin is a protein in your red blood cells that carries oxygen to your body's organs and tissues and transports carbon dioxide from your organs and tissues back to your lungs.









If a hemoglobin test reveals that your hemoglobin level is lower than normal, it means you have a low red blood cell count (anemia). Anemia can have many different causes, including vitamin deficiencies, bleeding and chronic diseases.

If a hemoglobin test shows a higher than normal level, there are several potential causes the blood disorder polycythemia vera, living at a high altitude, smoking and dehydration.

World sleep day is an annual, global call to spread awareness and explain the importance of healthy sleep. The aim of this day is to bring attention to the many burdens of sleepy problems.








Sleep is one of the most important activities of our life like eating healthy and exercising daily.





After the day- progress in construction of the classrooms, volunteers started with filtering the sand also helped in carrying the cement for construction of walls for classroom we finally completed the construction



















Regarding medical camp we made an awareness to each and every villagers in Peddapalem.






















MEDICAL CAMP
