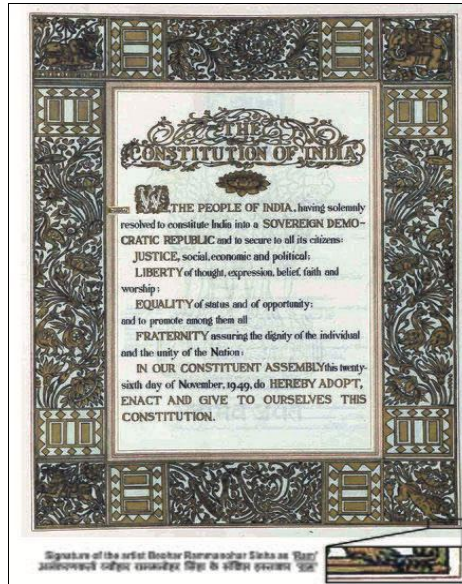
CONSTITUTIONAL DAY YOUTHCLUB ACTIVITIES

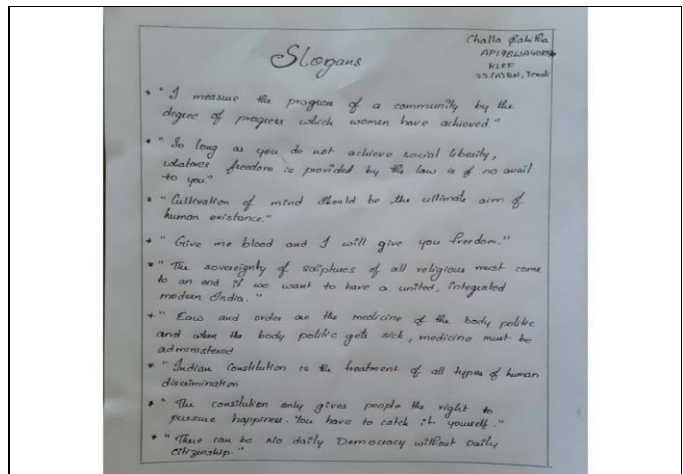
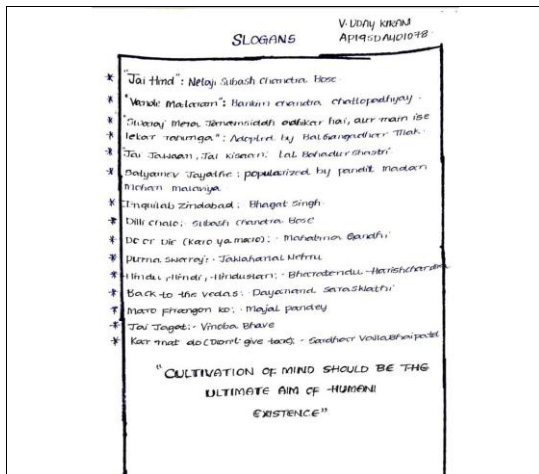
