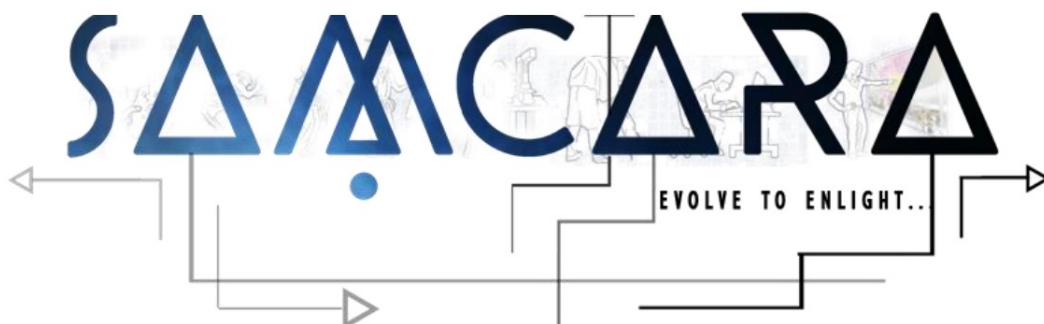
◆ SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE ◆

INSPIRATION



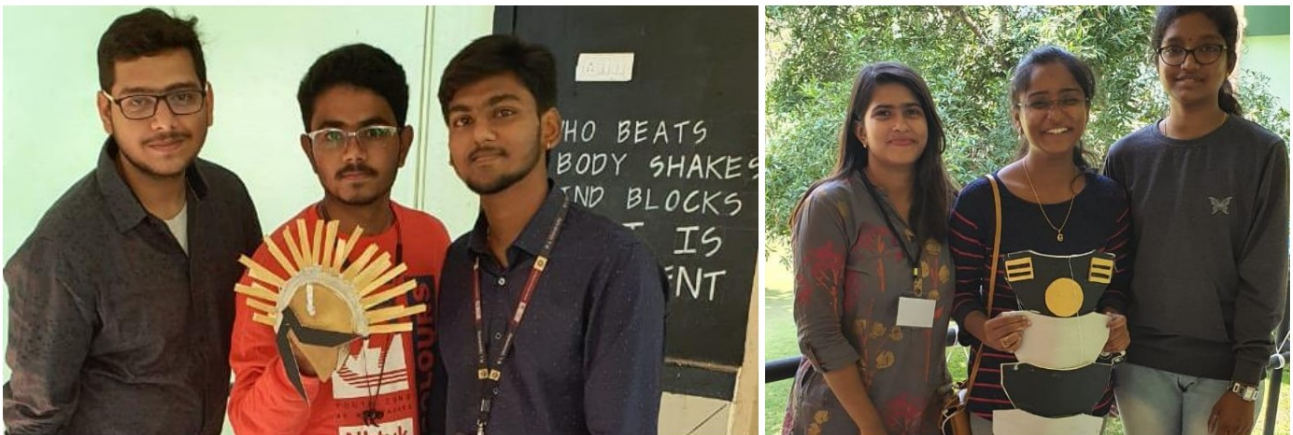
