The Koneru Lakshmaiah Charities was established as a trust in the year 1980 with its official address at Museum road, Governorpet, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh 520 002 and started KL College of Engineering in the Academic year 1980-81. KL Deemed to be university was established in 1980-81, as KL College of Engineering, which was upgraded to KL College of Engineering Autonomous in 2006 by UGC, and was declared as a Deemed to be University in 2009 by UGC, MHRD Govt. of India. In 2012 as a Deemed to be University the institution was accredited by NAAC with A Grade and later in 2018, was re-accredited by NAAC with A++ grade. In 2019 UGC, MHRD declared this intuition as Category I Institution.

Location:

K L Deemed to be University is situated in a spacious 100-acre campus on the banks of Buckingham Canal of River Krishna, Green Fields, Vaddeswaram, eight kilometers from Vijayawada City.

About Central Library:

The Central Library building is constructed in a centrally located with beautifully designed six floors as a green building having 2500 seating capacity with natural sunlight inside the library. The library is centralized air conditioning with modern seating facility for providing the users comfortable atmosphere for their reading and learning. The central library is fully computerized using Koha software to its in-house operations, with barcode and RFID technology for automatic self-issue/returns, access control and stock verification of library holdings. Library provides remote access facility to KLU user community to access the electronic resources.
