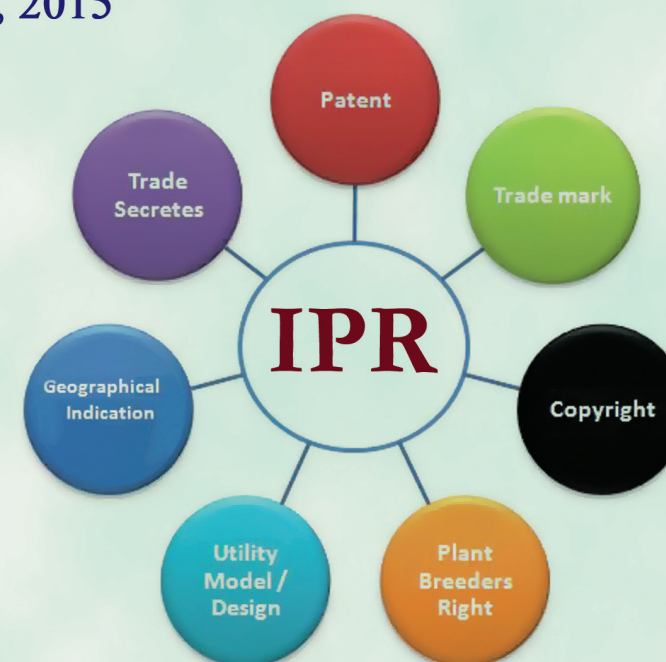

Preamble

The KL University is a pioneer in the field of Education and Research. It was established as KL College of Engineering in the year 1980. The college was made autonomous in the year 2006 and accorded the status of a Deemed University in 2009.

KL University is situated in a spacious 100 acres campus on the banks of Buckingham Canal of river Krishna, eight kilometers from Vijayawada city. Built within a rural setting of lush green fields, the institute is a virtual paradise of pristine nature and idyllic beauty. The campus has been aptly named 'Green Fields' and the splendid avenue of trees and gardens bear testimony to the importance of ecology and environment. The campus ambience is most befitting for scholastic pursuits. The University has been situated on a built up area of around 15,00,000 S.ft..

Central Library

The Central Library of KL University has a spacious area of 1400 sq.m. with 1,30,000 volumes of books, 500 National and International Journals, 4000 Back Volumes, and a Digital Library with 40 computers. It has subscribed to ASCE, ASME, IEEE, Springer, Science Direct, Ebsco Business Elite, Ebsco Hospitality and Tourism, ASTM, Oxford University Press, J-Gate on line Journals. It has currently developed Institutional Repository using D-space software. It is an institutional member in DELNET, New Delhi. The Central Library will be shifted to the new four floor centralized air conditioned building very soon.

About the Workshop

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) is rights granted to creators and owners of works that are results of human intellectual creativity. These works can be in the industrial, scientific, literary and artistic domains, which can be in the form of an invention, a manuscript, a suite of software, or a business name.

Intellectual Property Rights is a general term covering patents, copyright, trademark, industrial designs, geographical indications, protection of layout design of integrated circuits and protection of undisclosed information.

Scholarly communications is the creation, transformation, dissemination and preservation of knowledge related to teaching, research and scholarly endeavors. Among the many scholarly communications issues include author rights, the peer review process, the economics of scholarly resources, new models of publishing (including open access and institutional repositories), rights and access to federally funded research, and preservation of intellectual assets.
