

Library Collections

Library collections are shelved in the Ground, First and Second Floors. Ground Floor holds prescribed text books and other reading material covering syllabi of engineering and technology fields covering biotechnology, civil, computer science, electrical, electronics, electronics communications, mechanical and petroleum branches. Text books and reading material in the areas of architecture, business management, creative arts, and law are shelved in First Floor. All current print periodicals are also shelved here. In the Second Floor reference books covering all areas, back volumes, book bank collection and project reports and theses are shelved. In addition, Second Floor also provides access to digital library collections covering 19 e-resources and databases, and more than 21,000 e-journals through 125 Internet terminals.

While text book and book bank collections are loaned to users without any restrictions. Books in reference collection are not generally issued. However, under exceptional and special circumstances, these are issued for overnight reading only.
