OBJECTIVES

This summit aims to promote women's leadership and participation in various sectors, advocate for policies that ensure their rights and opportunities, raise awareness about gender-related issues, and celebrate the achievements of women as well as provide them with networking opportunities and access to resources, ultimately contributing to a more equitable and inclusive society where women's voices are heard, their rights are protected, and their contributions are valued.

DESCRIPTION

Women's day conducted on 8th march 2023 through our 3rd national women summit(online) on women empowerment has been a day of enlightenment.

Co-convener Dr. Lakshmi Prasanna, associate dean, IQAC has made this third national women summit organized by KLEF women's forum in collaboration with IQAC and academic staff college KLU a great intellectual and

motivational discourse. The themes chosen for this summit takes care of the need of the modern women to compete and succeed in her goals both at domestic front and professional profile.

During inaugural session, chief guest, Dr. D. Bhanu sree reddy, M.A., MBA, PHD (international relations) prof. Indian institute of science education and research (IISER) Tirupati has given her valuable suggestions for the women towards her empowerment in the light of the digitalized world.

This summit was conducted on 8 themes viz.,

1.women health –Dr. Kavita reddy, founder, director, Shreyas nutrition, for her precious guidance on health wherein she explained scientifically the benefits of each and every essential food item that supports body mind and functions of various parts of the human body. She advocated the significance of each and every nutrient that is required by each and every part of the human body and there by strongly recommended for the care to be taken by women regarding her health as a top priority a part from the health of the family members.

2. Self defense- Hephzibah Kolanti, recruitment and process delivery specialist, has explained the audience about the need of the hour to defend one self especially by the women for the various kinds of atrocities happening against the body and mind of the women. She also explained that the self defense mechanism would be of various types which includes physical and mental and the women must adopt the suitable defense depending upon the situation. She advocated that the mechanism of self defense must be a systematic process to be identified by each and every women and the same to be used as and when situation demands.

3. Sanitation and hygiene - saraswati kavula mam has explained the importance of the sanitation and hygiene in general and in particular for the women. She also gave her guidance towards education and culture. She has elaborated the significance of environment and the role of women for the same.

4. Literacy – Prof. N. Usha, dept of English, Krishna university, Rudrawaram, Machilipatnam, has emphasized the role of literacy in the life of a human being very particularly the women. She stressed upon the fact that woman is a central administrator of the home and in order to have qualitative administration, she should take the help of various kinds of literacy.

5. Women entrepreneurship – Mrs. Vyshali Sagar, AWS start up ramp lead, amazon internet services, Pvt, ltd. Has explained about the multiple avenues that are open for the women to establish her business skills. She contented that women has got a capability of commercial exploitation of her innovative skills.

6. Legal awareness – Dr. Satturu Rajani, special judge, POCSO, Vijayawada, has explained the significance of legal literacy for all sections of the society including the women. She also explained the supportive role for the same being extended by legal services authorities from Mandal level to national level. Madam has alerted the girl children about their abuse by male child has penalized under POCSO Act.

7. Technology for women - Darshiniarumugham, finance specialist in Hillenbrand Inc, Coimbatore, is a financial expert and as such stressed upon the financial literacy for all women including the girl students. She has explained the “index funding”, “rule of 72” et., and suggested the women to exploit these resources for their financial development. She strongly recommend for creation of Instagram account for the purpose of financial progress.

8. Women innovators- SumaAnne Gowda, Linked in expert, TEDx speaker, carried success, coach, inspirational speaker has explained the utility value of social media like linked in, meet up, XING, Angle list, indeed, etc.,

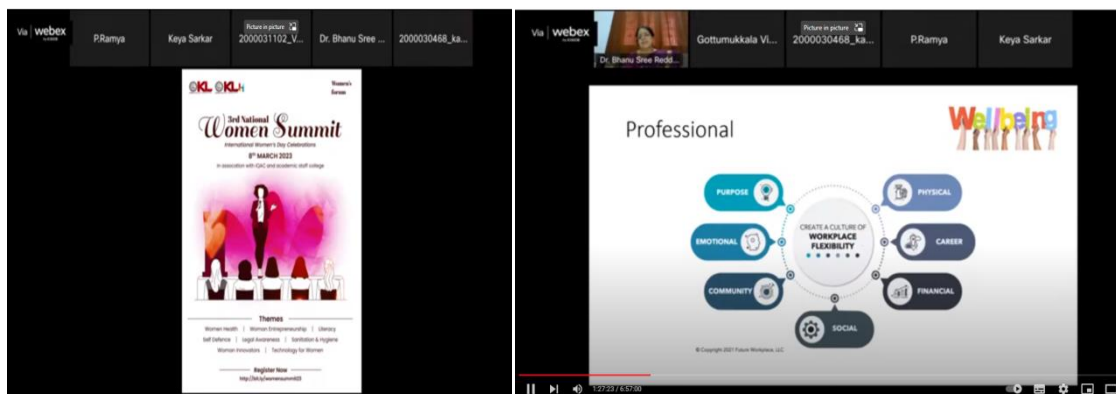
towards establishment of women's talent. She explained in detail as to how the linked in profile is to be managed from time to time for securing high profile jobs

This online summit extends the knowledge through its live session on YouTube too. This summit also facilitated and motivated the audience towards conduct of outreach programs in our respective fields.

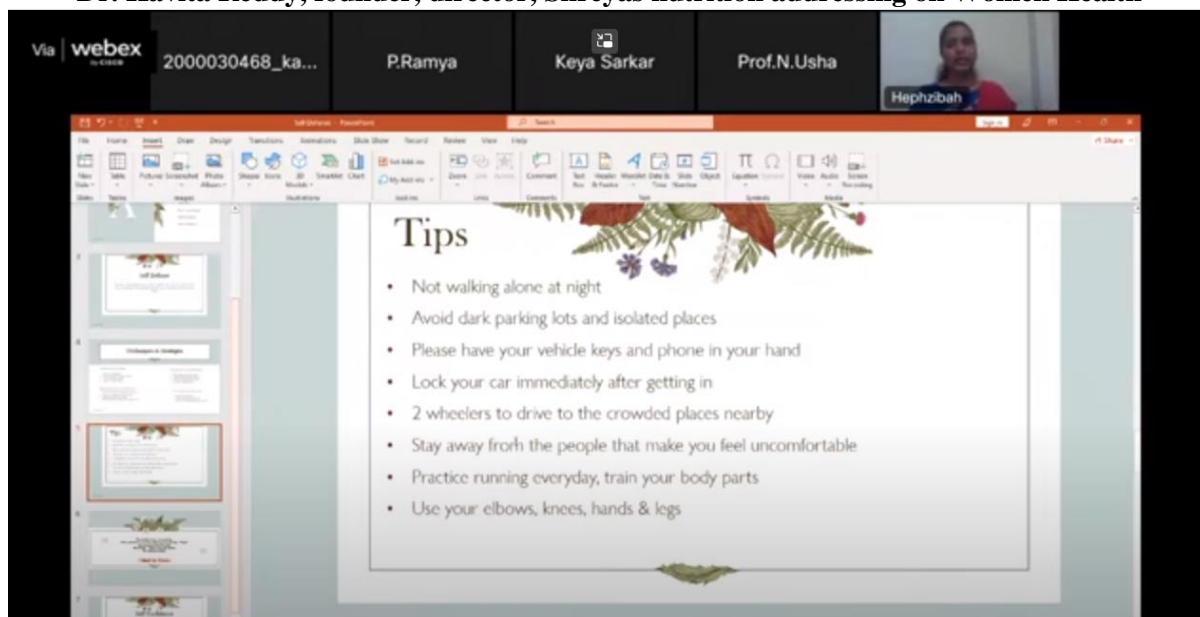
OUTCOMES

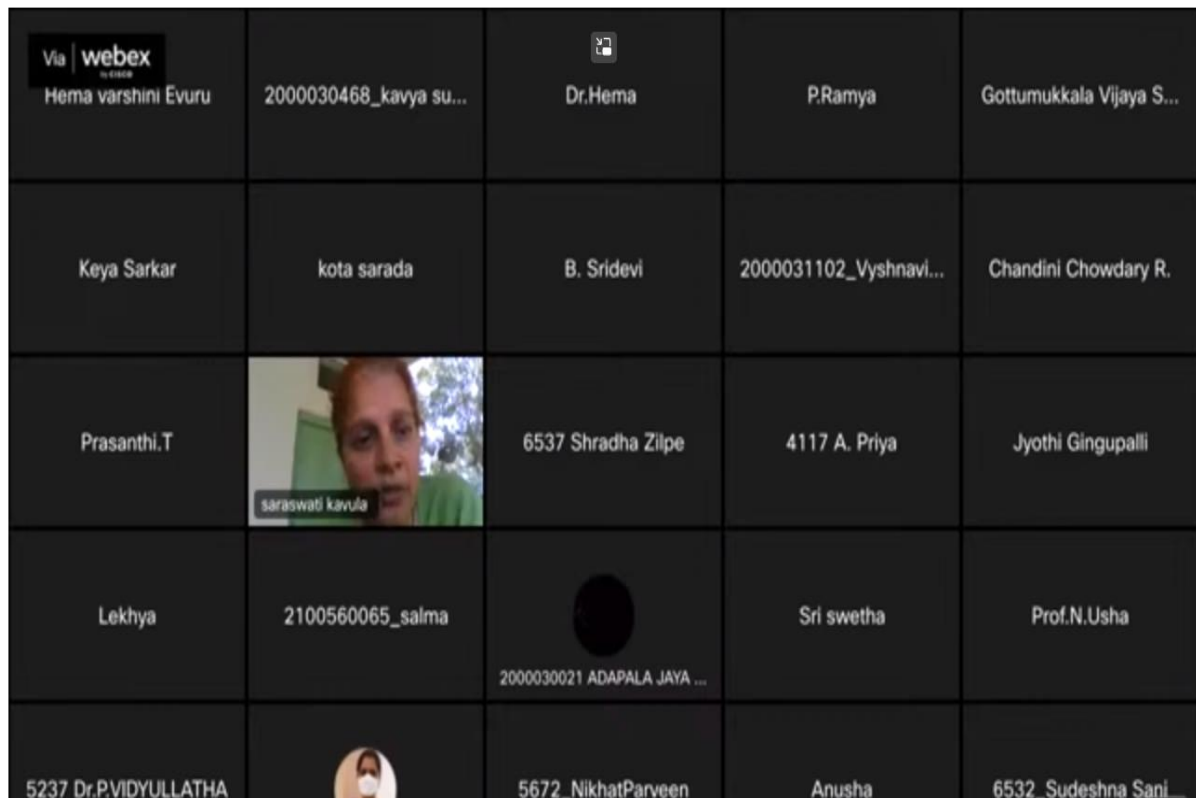
