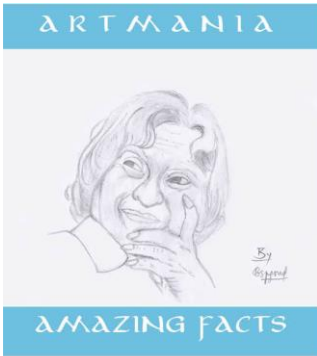

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BRAIN DRAIN
Abdul Kalam was born on 15th October 1931, Rameswaram on Pamban Island, in the Malabar, Tamil Nadu. His father Jajalingal was a boat owner his mother Aabamma was a housewife. His father owned a ferry that took Hindu pilgrims back and forth between Rameswaram, Kalam was the youngest of four brothers and one sister in his family. In his early childhood, Kalam's family had become poor at an early age, he sold newspapers to supplement his family income. In his school years, Kalam had average grades but was described as a bright and hardworking student who had a strong desire to learn. He spent hours on his studies, especially mathematics. After completing his education at the Schwartz Higher Secondary School, Rameswaram, Kalam attended to Saint Joseph's College, Tirunelveli, from where he graduated in physics in 1954. He moved to Madras in 1955 to study aerospace engineering in Madras Institute of Technology. In the 1970s, Abdul Kalam also directed two successful projects, Project Devil and Project Valiant. Kalam served as the 11th President of India, succeeding B. R. Neruram. He won the 2002 presidential election with an electoral vote of 922,884, surpassing the 107,566 vote won by Lalohari Singh. His term lasted from 25 July 2002 to 25 July 2007.

Once he was asked, "What will you like to be remembered for?" President, Scientist, Writer, Missile man, India 2002, Target 3 Billion... "What?" that would have made the question easier by giving options, but he sprang on a surprise. "Teacher," he said. In his last few hours, his hands cringed, there was stillness on his face as wide eyes radiating wisdom were motionless. He was taken to a general hospital and in another few minutes doctors indicated that missile man had flown away forever.

Let us summarize an instance from the writings of Chief Cashakumar's in a City School. "We've been born and bred in the melting pot of diversity. Celebrate it!" The writer in the story said, "Do push it to a person when they show respect."

5. What is the message that you would give to the discouraged youth?
If you have a goal or vision, then you should do everything you can to achieve it. You must have innovative ideas, discipline and focus on your dreams.
You had patience and never lose hope."

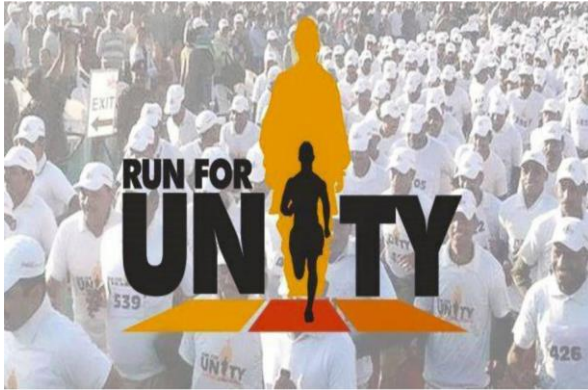

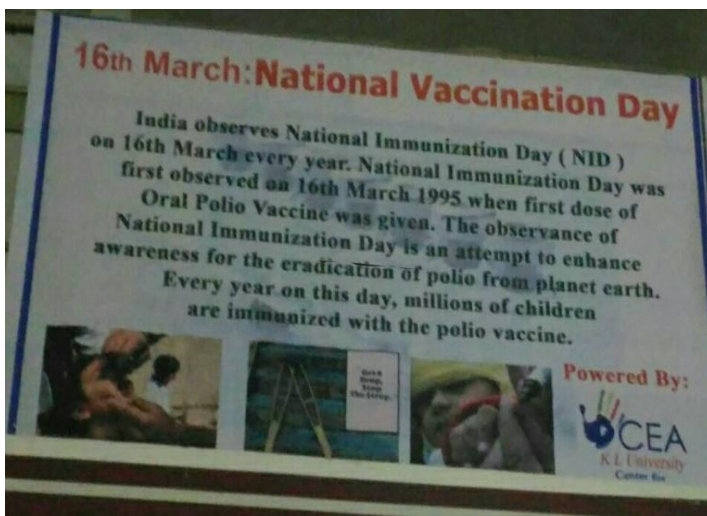
