Objective:

The objective of raising awareness on rainwater harvesting is to educate communities about the importance of conserving water for sustainable use. It aims to encourage individuals and households to collect and store rainwater for daily and agricultural purposes. The initiative seeks to reduce dependency on groundwater and prevent water scarcity in the long term. It promotes environmental conservation and responsible water management practices. Overall, the program fosters a culture of water sustainability and helps secure resources for future generations.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, under the Jal Shakti Abhiyan / National Water Mission and state-level water conservation schemes, the NSS Unit of the College of Agriculture, KL University, conducted a rainwater harvesting awareness program for the residents of Pedavadlapudi village in Mangalagiri Mandal on Monday, 22nd September 2025, informed Director Dr. P. Ratnaprasad.

During the event, College of Agriculture Head Dr. B. Balakrishna emphasized that water is the source of life for all living beings and advised villagers to adopt modern methods to overcome future water scarcity challenges. Volunteers educated the public on rainwater conservation measures and highlighted that water scarcity arises due to factors like erratic rainfall, wastage, overuse, and pollution.

NSS Programme Officers Dr. K. Vineel and Dr. S. Pradeep Kumar explained that water shortages can be reduced by implementing smart irrigation techniques, adopting water-saving practices in homes and agriculture, setting up rainwater storage tanks, and treating wastewater from industries and households for reuse in gardens, agriculture, and sanitation.

Dr. K. R. S. Prasad, Head of Student Affairs at KL University, noted that planting trees can enhance groundwater recharge through timely rainfall and that strict government regulations, along with proper water distribution planning, can help overcome water scarcity.

The participating volunteers and NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh were appreciated by KL University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasaradhi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. K.
