Minutes of Meeting of 42nd IQAC Advisory Committee Meeting

The 42nd Advisory Committee Meeting by Internal Quality Assurance Cell, KLEF was held on 31.12.2022.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Professor (Dr.) G. Pardha Saradhi Varma, in his foreword, welcomed all attendees and appreciated rigorous efforts put in by IQAC for assuring and enhancing quality in our KLEF. He highlighted some key features of NEP-2020 and appealed for everyone to get ready for implementing it. He particularly mentioned the need for a technology-driven Teaching learning process (TLP) which takes care of the learning outcome of each student, irrespective of his/her background.

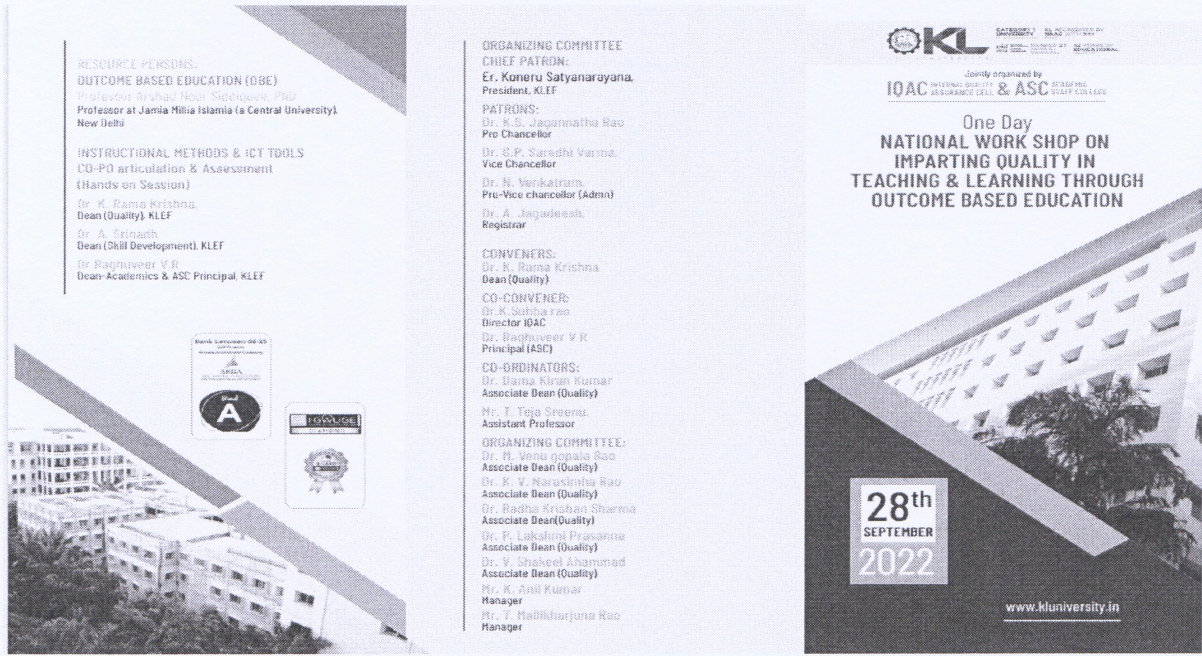

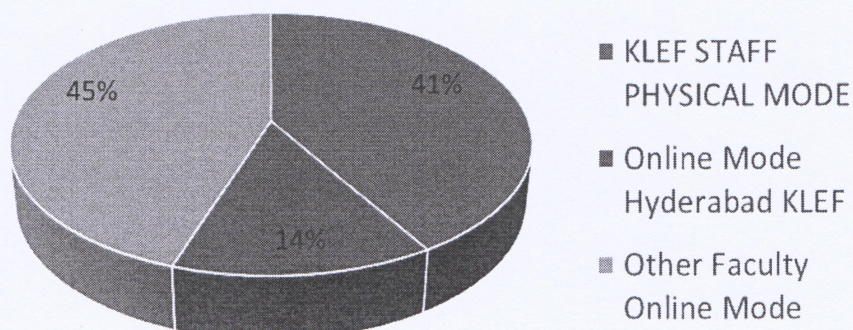

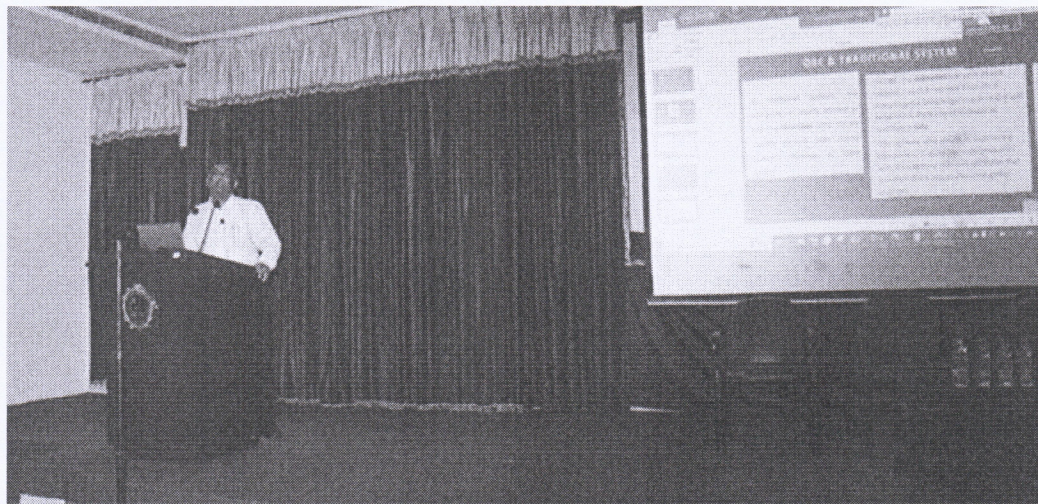

Reporting Item 2: Report on ISO 21001:2018 Certification audit (02-11-2022)

Some of the Observations of ISO 21001:2018 Education Management System 1st Surveillance Audit are as follows:

- Audit date: 29-10-2022
 - Auditor: Mr. T. G. Ganesan, BMQR Certification Private Limited, Chennai.
 - Auditees: Respective Department head and Team
 - Audit was conducted on 29-10-2022 for 19 Departments of the University.
- ISO 21001:2018 Audit Highlights:
- Departments ECE, ECS, MBA, and BHM have shown 100% Placements & College of Pharmacy has 90% Foreign Students.
 - Departments Computer Science and CS&IT, AI& DS highlighted the Global certifications for Students and Staff.
- ISO 21001:2018 Audit Non-compliances vis-à-vis Recommendations:
- Master List of documents not available with respect to ISO 21001:2018 Education Management System.
 - Education management system main manual is not available.
 - The Internal auditors are not qualified for conducting ISO 21001:2018 audit. It is suggested to make at least 2-3 senior faculty of IQAC as Qualified Auditors for conducting internal audit.

At this juncture, the Dean-Quality requested the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to permit two senior faculty from IQAC to get trained and certified for ISO 21001:2018 Certification. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor at once approved the proposal.

Terms of Reference:

- To conduct the Audit based on NAAC Metrics and assess the targets achieved up to 2022.
- To make recommendations to improve the performance concerning the seven criteria given by NAAC.

The Committee may deem fit to assess any other academic/administrative issues related to the above NAAC criteria.

➤ **Important Recommendations:**

1. The Audit team praised the efforts of the Management in creating and maintaining such a wonderful campus with greenery and landscaping. They felt the name 'Green Fields' is very aptly coined.
2. The faculty should be encouraged to apply for projects from external funding agencies, viz. UGC, DST, DBT, etc.
3. Placement with higher packages and entrepreneurship development programs may be encouraged.
4. Student diversity based on demographic location factors may be encouraged.
5. Online Distance and Learning (ODE) may be gradually closed to avoid any further implications on the resources and ranking of the University.

Theme for 2022 is "Quality conscience: Doing the right thing."

The main objectives of the World Quality Day are:

B. Organizing Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) through external experts.

- The Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) was conducted during 4 - 5 November 2022 and the detailed report was communicated to various functionaries.

C. Developing IQAC-ERP

- The updating of IQAC-ERP is under process.

D. Use of GANTT Charts for planning and monitoring

In view of the lack of awareness and knowledge about GANTT Charts with the majority of KLEF Faculty, this proposal is kept under abeyance for the present.

E. Quality Initiative (Academic domain)

- Dean-Academics was informed to implement the quality initiative proposed by IQAC in terms of arranging the number of contact hours and the number of COs based on the number of credits for various courses from the next AY_2023-24.

Agenda Item 2: Proposed Quality initiatives:

(a). Integration of the Indian Knowledge System (teaching in Indian Language, and culture, using online courses) in view of NEP 2020.

IQAC proposes to offer Basic Sanskrit Language as a 3-0-0-0 Elective course from the upcoming academic year, 2023-24.

Resolution: It is resolved to offer Basic Sanskrit Language as a 3-0-0-0 Elective course from the upcoming academic year, 2023-24.

Responsible Person: Dean-Academics

(b). Establishment of Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) with both faculty and students to organize the following activities:

- a. Assist district election administration in the conduct of polls.
- b. To undertake socially relevant projects/initiatives in electoral-related issues.
- c. To institutionalize mechanisms to register eligible students as voters.
- d. To conduct Voter awareness campaigns, promotion of ethical voting, enhancing the participation of the underprivileged sections of society especially transgender, commercial sex workers, disabled persons, senior Citizens, etc.

Resolution: It is resolved to establish Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) with both faculty and students as members.

Responsible Person: Dean-Student Affairs

(c). To explore the possibility of KLUBS going for AACSB (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) and AMBA Accreditations.

As on today, there are 190 Business schools worldwide that hold the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business's (AACSB) Accounting Accreditation, out of which 21 are from India. Similarly, the Association of MBAs (AMBA) has *accredited* MBA, DBA

and MBM programmes at 277 graduate business schools in 57 countries and territories (as of 2020). IQAC proposes KLUBS to explore the possibility of getting both **AACSB** (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) and **AMBA** Accreditation soon to enhance its branding.

Resolution: Resolved to explore the possibility of KLUBS going for AACSB (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) and AMBA Accreditations.

Responsible Person: Dean-MHS

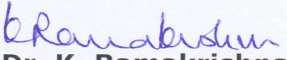
Agenda Item 3: Any other item, with the permission of the chair.
