

Minutes of 32nd IQAC Advisory Committee Meeting

Dr. L. S. S. Reddy, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, KLEF chaired the 32nd IQAC Advisory Committee meeting. He commenced the meeting by welcoming the members with the following opening remarks:

KLEF was closed during 23 March – 2 June 2020 (72 Days) due to the lockdown announced by the Central/State Governments and reopened on 3 June 2020 with only faculty and non-teaching staff and no students. This is to strictly ensure social distancing in view of the Covid-109 pandemic. Also, the gap between the previous meeting and today's meeting is hardly four weeks. This is due to the delay in conducting the previous meeting. Hence, the agenda items are few in number.

After this, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor handed over to Dr. K Rama Krishna, Dean (Quality) to continue further and take up the agenda for the meeting. The Agenda Items for discussion are given below.

Agenda Point 1: QS I Gauge E-LEAD certified

Dr. K Ramakrishna, Dean-Quality informed the members that KLEF bagged the prestigious E-LEAD Certification by QS I Gauge for exhibiting its abilities to provide quality online education. KLEF scored 150 marks out of the maximum possible marks of 150. The Dean-Quality has on record placed thanks to Professor Hari Kiran Vege, Head, Dept of CSE for his support in compiling and providing the necessary data to QS I Gauge in this regard.

All the members appreciated the efforts of IQAC and all the functionaries of the University concerned for this Achievement.

Agenda Point 2: Discussion on Central facilities audit.

The Dean (Quality) has informed the members that IQAC was in the middle of conducting the audit of central facilities, viz. All Canteens & Cafeterias, Health Centers & Sports, hostels, ET facilities, Wi-Fi & Systems & Technology, Library and transportation when KLEF was closed due to lockdown. The Dean (Quality) requested the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to permit IQAC to complete the audit of the remaining central facilities (Library and transportation) later this week, for which approval was accorded.

Agenda Point 3: Quality Circles (Students)' feedback

Dr. K Ramakrishna, Dean-Quality has briefed the members about the feedback received during the Quality Circles (Students)' meeting conduced on 18 March 2020. Most of the issues are related to Wi-Fi speed, maintenance and water quality.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor informed that most of the issues have been attended to.

Agenda Point 4: Achievement of Ms. K. Vyshnavi, Student of KLEF

Dr. K Ramakrishna, Dean-Quality informed that Ms. Vyshnavi Kandikatla, student of III/IV B. Tech. (CSE), Roll No. 170030547, KLEF has stood among the first ten girl students in the country in the event organized by QS I Gauge. As a result of this, she was able to interact with Smt. Smriti Irani, Hon'ble Union Minister for Women and Child Development [Participation in Women Entrepreneurship through the Lens of Higher Education]. Ms. Vaishnavi was polled more votes than anyone else in the competition. She was also awarded a cash prize of Rs. 1000/- by QS I Gauge as a token of appreciation. All the members congratulated Ms. Vyshnavi for this achievement at National level.

The meeting was adjourned with the Hon'ble Vice Chanceller thanking the members for their cooperation.
