

Instructions to Candidates Appearing for Pre-Ph.D. Examination

All candidates appearing for the **Pre-Ph.D. Examination** are required to strictly follow the instructions given below:

1. **Reporting Time:**

Candidates must report to the examination hall **at least 30 minutes before** the scheduled commencement of the examination.

2. **Admit Card / Identification:**

Candidates must carry their **Hall Ticket / Admit Card and a valid Photo Identity Card**. Candidates without proper identification will not be permitted to enter the examination hall.

3. **Seating Arrangement:**

Candidates should occupy the **seat allotted to them** as per the seating plan displayed outside the examination hall. No candidate shall change their seat without permission from the invigilator.

4. **Prohibited Items:**

The following items are **strictly prohibited** inside the examination hall:

- Mobile phones
- Smart watches
- Electronic gadgets
- Books, notes, or any study materials

Possession or use of such items will be treated as **unfair means** and may lead to disciplinary action.

5. **Stationery:**

Candidates must bring their **own pens and other permitted stationery**. Borrowing or exchanging materials during the examination is not allowed.

6. **Answer Booklet:**

Candidates must write their **Registration Number and other required details** clearly in the space provided on the answer booklet.

7. **Conduct in the Examination Hall:**

Candidates must maintain **silence and discipline** in the examination hall. Any form of communication, copying, or misconduct will result in strict action as per university rules.

8. **Leaving the Examination Hall:**

No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall **during the first 30 minutes** of the examination. Candidates must submit their answer booklet to the invigilator before leaving the hall.

9. **Compliance with Instructions:**

Candidates must strictly follow the **instructions given by the invigilators and examination authorities**.

Failure to comply with the above instructions may result in **disqualification from the examination**.
