Introduction:

A visit has been organized by the KL College of Agriculture for II-year I semester students on 09-09-2025.

Session Activities: The students were accompanied by 3 faculty members. Dr. Ramakant, Director, KL Incubation Centre addressed our students on incubation activities and MSME policies.

1. Introduction

Interactions with incubated startups provided first-hand insight into the challenges faced by MSMEs and how the incubation centre's guidance helped them leverage government schemes effectively
