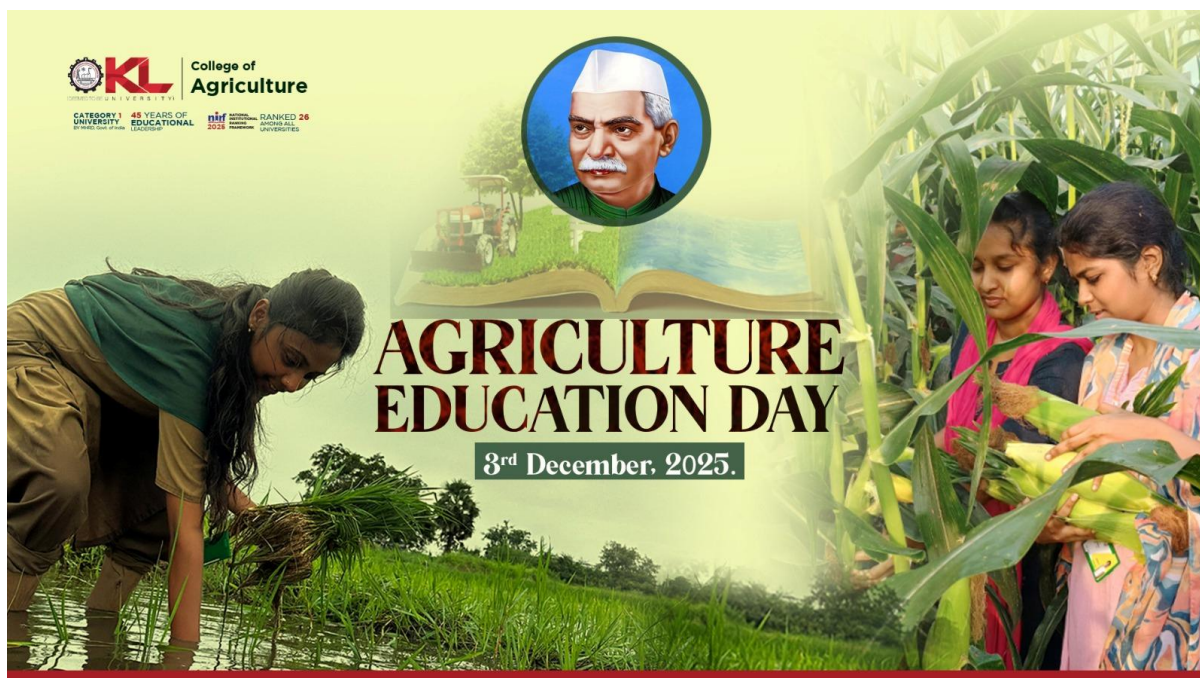

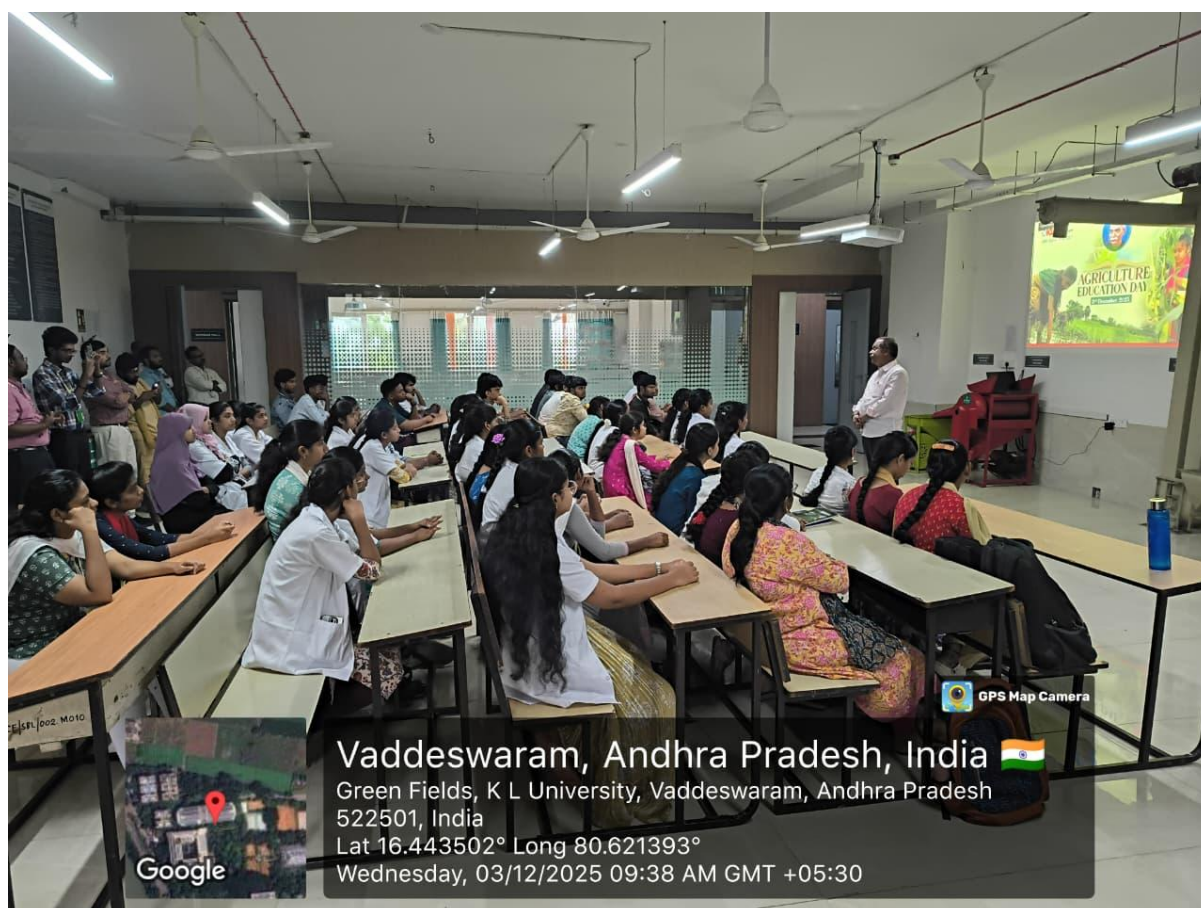
Conclusion
