Hybrid Gold


Documents that are in journals which provide authors the choice of publishing open access.





Figure 1. Vagrant scientist appeals to passers-by (drawing by Heg)

UGC Guidelines Regarding Plagiarism

Penalties in case of plagiarism in submission of thesis and dissertations

Levels of Plagiarism

- i. Level 0: Similarities upto 10%** - Minor Similarities, no penalty.
- ii. Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40%** - Such student shall be asked to submit a revised script within a stipulated time period not exceeding 6 months.
- iii. Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60%** - Such student shall be debarred from submitting a revised script for a period of one year.
- iv. Level 3: Similarities above 60%** -Such student registration for that programme shall be cancelled.

UGC Guidelines Regarding Plagiarism

Penalties in case of plagiarism in academic and research publications

Levels of Plagiarism

I. Level 0: Similarities up to 10% - Minor similarities, no penalty.

II. Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40% - Shall be asked to withdraw manuscript.

III. Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60%

i) Shall be asked to withdraw manuscript.

ii) Shall be denied a right to one annual increment.

iii) Shall not be allowed to be a supervisor to any new Master's, M.Phil., Ph.D. Student/scholar for a period of two years.

IV. Level 3: Similarities above 60%

i) Shall be asked to withdraw manuscript.

ii) Shall be denied a right to two successive annual increments.

iii) Shall not be allowed to be a supervisor to any new Master's, M.Phil., Ph.D. Student/scholar for a period of three years.






