SOCIAL IMMERSIVE LEARNING – CYBERSECURITY AWARENESS PROGRAM

The Department of Arts (B.A-IAS), KL University, organized a **Cybersecurity Awareness Program** under the **Social Immersive Learning (SIL)** initiative to promote **digital safety and literacy** among rural citizens of **Vaddeshwaram and Ippatam**. The program aimed to educate residents on protecting personal data, identifying online scams, creating strong passwords, and enabling two-factor authentication. Through workshops, live demonstrations, and interactive sessions, students helped villagers understand the importance of safe browsing habits and social media security. Awareness materials such as posters and leaflets made the sessions engaging and accessible to all age groups.



The initiative provided students with a platform to **connect academic knowledge with community service**, enhancing their communication, teamwork, and social responsibility skills. Community feedback reflected a positive impact, with participants showing improved awareness of cybersecurity practices. The Department recommended conducting regular training sessions and forming local volunteer groups to sustain awareness. Overall, the program successfully contributed to building a **digitally aware and secure rural community**, aligning with India's **Smart Village Revolution** and KL University's vision of social empowerment through education.



AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON “NATIONAL WOMEN’S EQUALITY DAY”

The Department of Arts, in association with NSS, organized an Awareness Rally on *National Women’s Equality Day* on **30th August 2025** at **Vaddeshwaram**. The programme aimed to promote gender equality, highlight women’s rights, and encourage inclusive opportunities in education, employment, and leadership.



The rally, held from **10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.**, saw active participation from **47 students and 3 faculty members**, spreading powerful messages through placards and slogans. The event emphasized the importance of breaking gender stereotypes and fostering respect and equal opportunities for women. This initiative created a meaningful impact by sensitizing the community, benefiting nearly **1,594 people**, and inspiring youth to advocate for equality, empowerment, and social responsibility.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON "SPREADING AWARENESS ABOUT CHILD EDUCATION"

Date: 20th September, 2025

Place: Atmakur

The Department of Arts, in association with NSS, organized an impactful Awareness Programme on "Spreading Awareness About Child Education" on 20th September 2025 at Atmakur from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The event focused on educating the community about the importance of ensuring that every child receives access to schooling and highlighted various government schemes supporting free and inclusive education. A street rally with inspiring slogans and placards helped draw the attention of local residents and parents, motivating many to enroll their children—especially girls—in nearby schools. The initiative created a positive shift in community attitudes, encouraged youth participation in volunteer tutoring, and strengthened the collective commitment toward universal literacy. With the participation of **23 students and 3 faculty members**, the programme successfully promoted the message that child education is a fundamental right and a vital step toward building an empowered society.



OBJECTIVE OF THE EVENT:

The programme aimed to educate parents and community members about the vital role of child education in building a brighter future, while also informing them about various government schemes and free educational opportunities available for underprivileged children. It further sought to motivate school dropouts to return to their studies and continue their learning journey. Additionally, the initiative emphasized the importance of active community involvement in supporting and strengthening education for every child, ensuring inclusive growth and equal opportunities for all.



Study Tour to VMRDA

Visakhapatnam Metropolitan Region Development Authority, Andhra Pradesh



As part of the study tour and experiential learning programme, the third-year B.A. (IAS Orientation) students visited the Visakhapatnam Metropolitan Region Development Authority (VMRDA). The tour provided practical exposure to urban governance, metropolitan planning, and developmental administration, complementing the IAS-oriented curriculum focused on governance and public policy.

The visit aimed to help students understand the structure and functioning of VMRDA, learn about urban planning and zoning regulations, interact with officials on metropolitan governance, and gain insights into the implementation of government projects and Smart City initiatives. Students gained a clear understanding of the operational framework of metropolitan development authorities, the role of regional planning, Smart City and green space initiatives, and the mechanisms of public policy implementation. They also observed real-time administrative coordination and decision-making processes.

As part of the VMRDA study tour, the 3rd Year B.A. (IAS Orientation) students had the unique opportunity to interact with the Hon'ble MLA of Visakhapatnam (East), Shri Vamsi Krishna Yadav. The session aimed to give students practical insights into democratic leadership, constituency development, and the role of elected representatives in urban governance.

The interaction helped students understand the responsibilities of an MLA in city planning and public administration, the coordination involved with bodies such as VMRDA, GVMC, and district authorities, and the importance of youth participation and leadership in democratic processes. Shri Vamsi Krishna Yadav shared his developmental vision for Visakhapatnam, focusing on infrastructure, tourism, youth welfare, and public services. He explained how MLAs collaborate with planning authorities to ensure inclusive and sustainable development. Emphasizing ethics, accountability, and community engagement, he encouraged students to be active



citizens and aspire to leadership roles, particularly through Civil Services. The MLA also addressed student questions on governance, constituency management, and policy implementation. Shri Vamsi Krishna Yadav shared his experiences as a public representative and outlined his vision for the overall development of Visakhapatnam. He highlighted key priorities such as infrastructure enhancement, tourism growth, youth welfare programmes, and improved public service delivery.

He also explained the collaborative role of MLAs in working with planning and development authorities to ensure sustainable and citizen-friendly urban growth. Emphasizing the values of ethics, accountability, and community engagement, he urged students to stay socially responsible and actively participate in civic processes.

Educational Visit to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly

As part of the experiential learning component of the B.A. (IAS Orientation) programme, the Department of Arts organised an educational visit to the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly. The visit was designed to provide students with firsthand exposure to democratic institutions and legislative functioning, strengthening their understanding of governance and public administration.

Objective of the Visit

The visit aimed to help students understand the structure and functioning of the State Legislative Assembly and Council, observe real-time legislative proceedings, and learn about the roles of elected representatives and parliamentary procedures. It also served to bridge classroom learning on the Constitution and governance with practical legislative experience. Students had the rare opportunity to witness live sessions of both the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council. They observed how questions were raised, debates were conducted, and decisions were made following established parliamentary rules. The visit provided insights into the functioning of a bicameral legislature, the responsibilities of the Speaker and Chairman, and key mechanisms such as Question Hour, Zero Hour, and legislative debates. This experience offered valuable learning on legislative accountability, transparency, and the practical workings of democratic governance.
