Event : Awareness on Eye Care and Vision

Objective:

The primary objective of the event “*Awareness on Eye Care and Vision*” conducted on **07-04-2026** at **Ravendrapadu** was to educate the rural community about the significance of maintaining proper eye health and preventing vision-related disorders. The program aimed to spread awareness about common eye problems such as refractive errors, eye infections, and age-related vision issues. It also focused on highlighting the importance of regular eye check-ups, early diagnosis, and timely

treatment to avoid complications. Additionally, the event intended to encourage healthy lifestyle practices, including proper nutrition and reduced screen exposure, to promote long-term eye health.

Description:

An awareness program on eye care and vision was successfully organized on **07-04-2026** at **Ravendrapadu**, targeting people of all age groups. The session began with an introduction to the structure and function of the human eye, followed by an explanation of common eye disorders and their causes. The participants were educated on maintaining proper eye hygiene, such as washing eyes with clean water, avoiding touching or rubbing eyes with unclean hands, and protecting eyes from dust and harmful environmental factors.

Special emphasis was given to the increasing impact of digital devices on eye health, explaining problems like digital eye strain and dryness caused by prolonged screen time. The importance of a balanced diet rich in vitamins, especially Vitamin A, for maintaining good vision was also discussed.

The session was interactive, where participants actively engaged by asking questions and sharing their personal experiences related to eye problems. Practical tips and preventive measures were demonstrated in a simple and understandable manner to ensure better adoption by the villagers.

Outcome:

The awareness program resulted in a noticeable improvement in the participants' understanding of eye care and vision health. People became more conscious about maintaining eye hygiene and recognized the importance of early detection of eye-related issues. Many participants expressed their willingness to undergo regular eye check-ups and adopt healthier habits, such as reducing excessive screen time and improving their diet.

The program also helped in clearing misconceptions about eye diseases and treatments, thereby promoting a more informed and responsible approach toward eye health within the community.

Impact on Society:

The program had a positive impact on society by promoting awareness and encouraging preventive healthcare practices related to eye health. It contributed to reducing ignorance and negligence towards vision problems, especially in rural areas where access to medical knowledge is limited.
