#### Objective:

The objective of the **Basic Awareness on Medicines and Resistance** program conducted on **09-04-2026** at **Chinna Kakani** was to educate the local community about the proper use of medicines and the growing issue of drug resistance. The program aimed to create awareness about how misuse and overuse of medicines, especially antibiotics, can lead to resistance, making treatments less effective. It also focused on promoting responsible medication practices, such as following prescriptions, avoiding self-medication, and completing the full course of treatment. Additionally, the initiative encouraged individuals to spread awareness within their families and community for better health practices.

### **Description:**

As part of the NSS outreach activity, the awareness program on medicines and resistance was conducted on **09-04-2026 at Chinna Kakani** to inform the local community about safe medication practices and the dangers of drug resistance.

The session began with a simple introduction to medicines, explaining their role in treating diseases and improving health. The concept of antibiotic resistance was explained in an easy and understandable manner, highlighting how bacteria become resistant when medicines are misused or not taken properly.

Common mistakes such as self-medication, skipping doses, stopping medicines early, and using antibiotics without a doctor's advice were discussed. The importance of consulting healthcare professionals, taking the correct dosage, and completing the prescribed course of medicines was clearly emphasized.

The session also included examples from daily life to help villagers relate to the topic. Preventive measures such as maintaining hygiene, avoiding unnecessary antibiotic use, and spreading correct information were highlighted. The program was interactive, with participants asking questions and clearing their doubts, making the session engaging and effective.

### **Outcome:**

The program successfully increased awareness among the participants regarding the proper use of medicines and the dangers of drug resistance. People gained a clear understanding of how misuse of antibiotics and other medicines can reduce their effectiveness over time. They learned the importance of following doctors' prescriptions, avoiding self-medication, and completing the full course of treatment. Participants became more conscious about their medication habits and showed interest in adopting safer and more responsible practices. Many expressed willingness to share the information with their family members and neighbours. Overall, the session helped in developing a better understanding of responsible medicine use and contributed to building a more health-aware community.

### **Impact on Society:**

This awareness program created a positive impact on society by educating people at the grassroots level about responsible medicine use. When individuals understand the importance of proper medication and the risks of resistance, it helps in reducing the misuse of drugs and prevents the spread of resistant infections.

The knowledge gained during the session can be shared within families and the wider community, leading to improved health awareness and safer practices. In the long

run, such initiatives contribute to better public health, reduced healthcare costs, and more effective treatments. It also helps in building a responsible and informed society that understands the importance of using medicines wisely.
