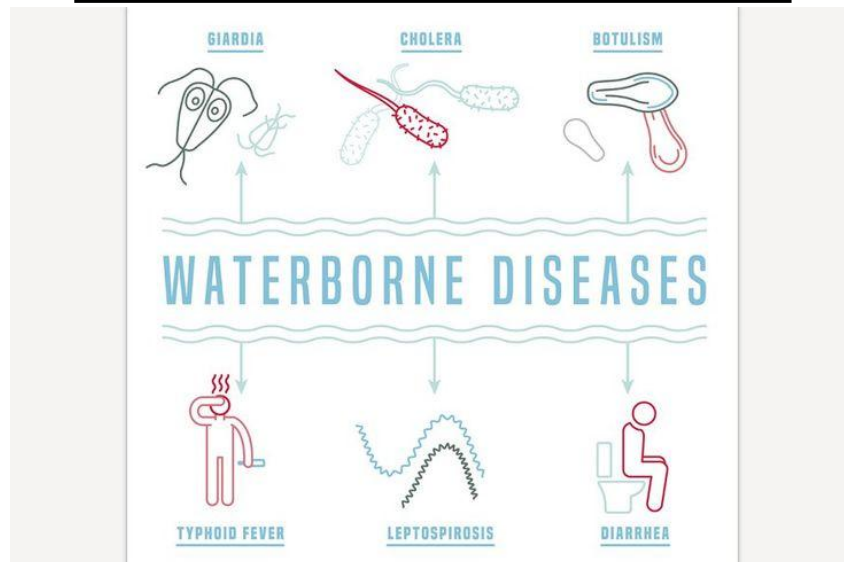

Event : Awareness on Waterborne Diseases

Date : 02-04-2026

Objective:

The objective of the **Awareness Program on Waterborne Diseases** conducted on **02-04-2026 at Pedakonduru** was to create awareness among the local community about waterborne diseases, their causes, symptoms, and preventive measures. The program aimed to help people understand how contaminated water and poor sanitation contribute to the spread of diseases. It also focused on promoting the importance of safe drinking water, personal hygiene, and cleanliness. Additionally, the initiative encouraged individuals to adopt healthy practices and spread awareness within their families and the community.

Description:

As part of the outreach activity, the **Awareness Program on Waterborne Diseases** was conducted on **02-04-2026 at Pedakonduru** to educate the local community about the risks associated with unsafe water and poor hygiene.

The session began with a basic introduction to waterborne diseases, explaining how they spread through contaminated water. Common diseases such as cholera, typhoid, diarrhea, and hepatitis were discussed in a simple and

understandable manner. The causes of these diseases, including consumption of polluted water, improper sanitation, and lack of cleanliness, were clearly explained.

The symptoms of waterborne diseases such as stomach pain, vomiting, fever, dehydration, and weakness were discussed to help people identify them at an early stage. The program mainly focused on preventive measures like drinking boiled or filtered water, maintaining personal hygiene, washing hands regularly, and keeping the surroundings clean.

To make the session more effective, simple explanations, real-life examples, and interactive discussions were used. The villagers actively participated, asked questions, and clarified their doubts. The session created a comfortable and engaging environment for learning.

Outcome:

The program successfully improved the awareness level of the participants regarding waterborne diseases and their prevention. People gained clear knowledge about how these diseases spread and how they can be avoided through simple daily practices. They understood the importance of boiling or filtering water, maintaining hygiene, and recognizing early symptoms. Many participants showed interest in adopting healthier habits and expressed willingness to share this knowledge with others. Overall, the session helped in building a more health-conscious mindset among the villagers.

Impact on Society:

This awareness program created a positive impact on society by educating the community at the grassroots level. When people become aware of safe water practices and hygiene, it helps in reducing the spread of waterborne diseases. The information shared during the program can spread from one person to another, gradually improving the overall health of the village. In the long run, such initiatives can lead to better sanitation practices, fewer health issues, and reduced medical expenses. It also contributes to building a more responsible, informed, and healthier society.

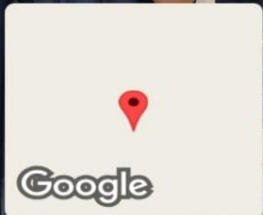
