Furthermore, societal norms and beliefs about death and the afterlife can impact organ donation rates. Education and awareness campaigns aimed at addressing these



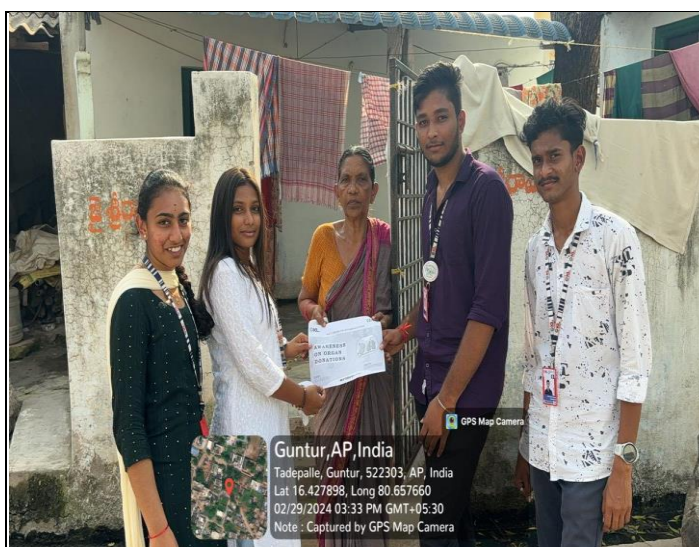
beliefs and dispelling myths can help increase donation rates.
