Outcome:

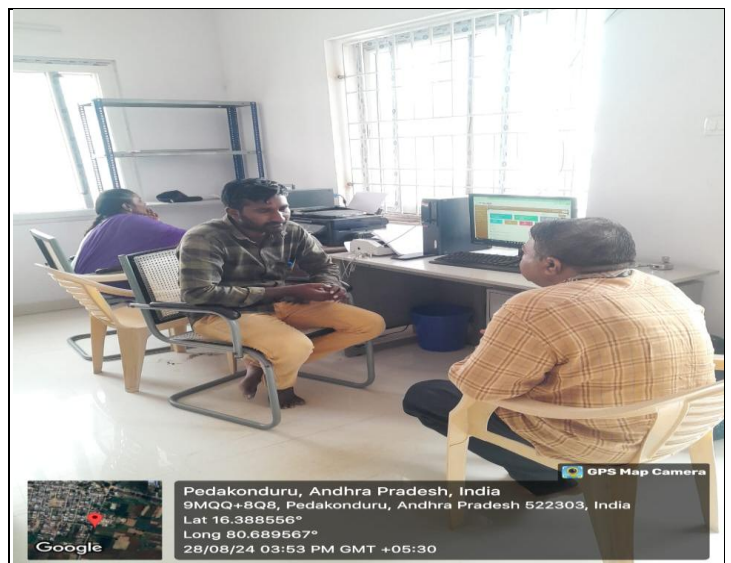
