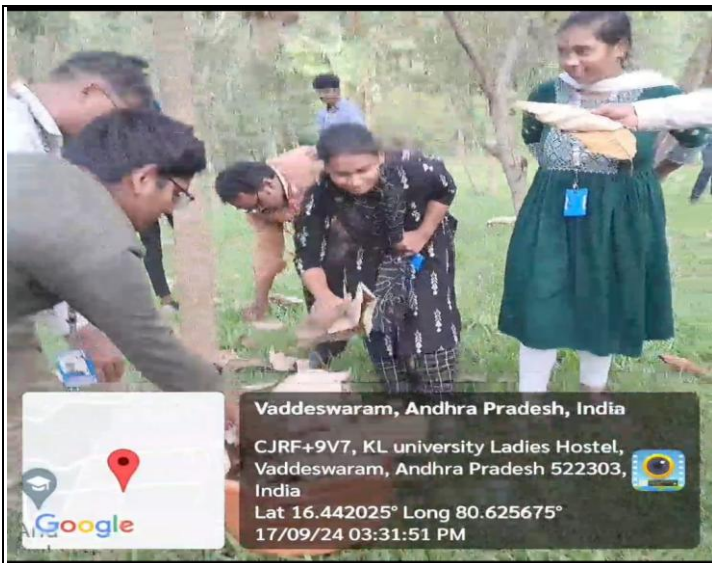
### **Impact of the Society:**
