Outcome:

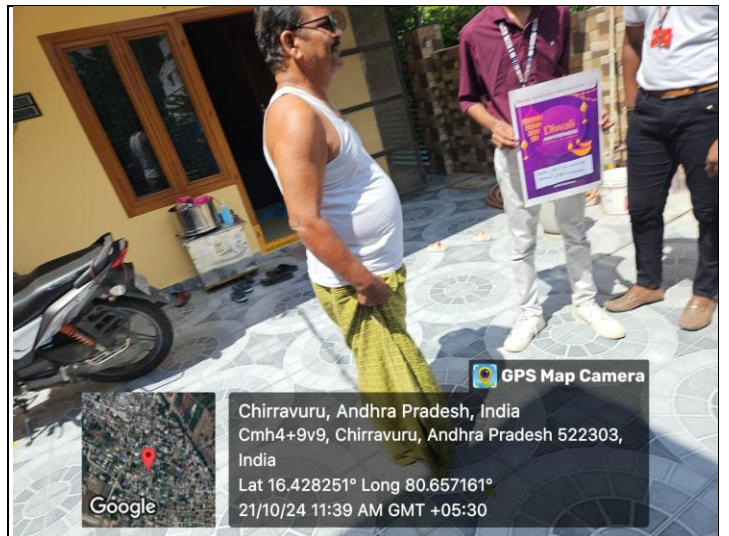
