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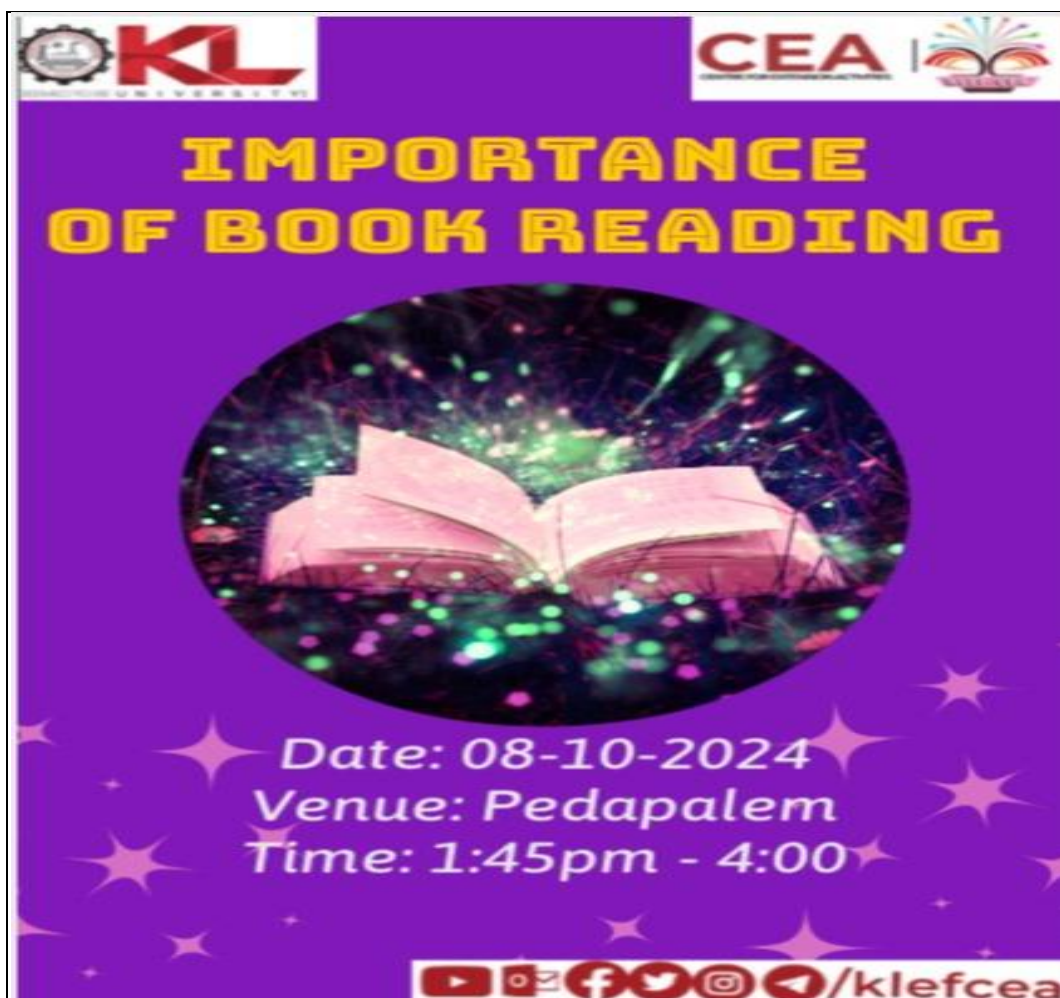
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A report on “Importance of Book Reading” 29/10/2024 at Z.P. High School, Pedavaldapudi Village

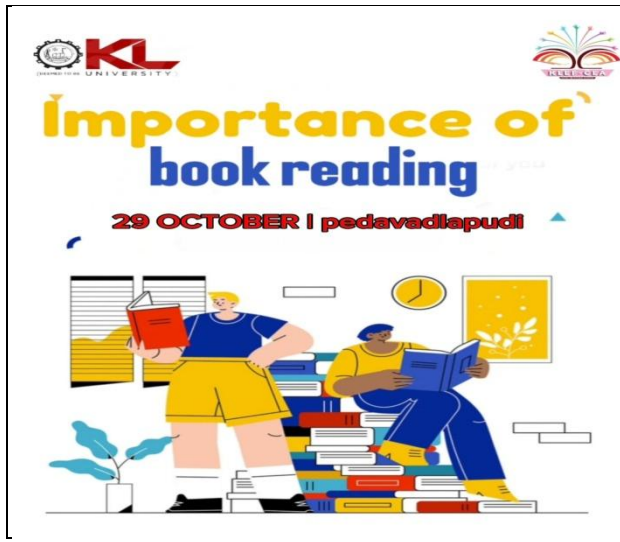
Outcome:
