Outcome:

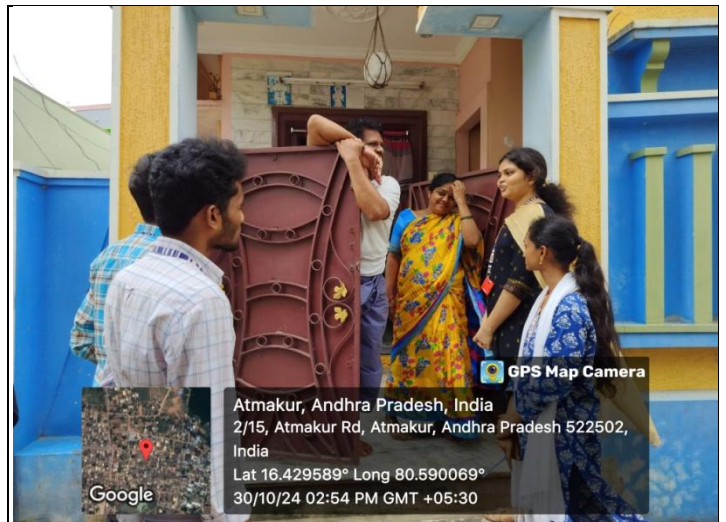
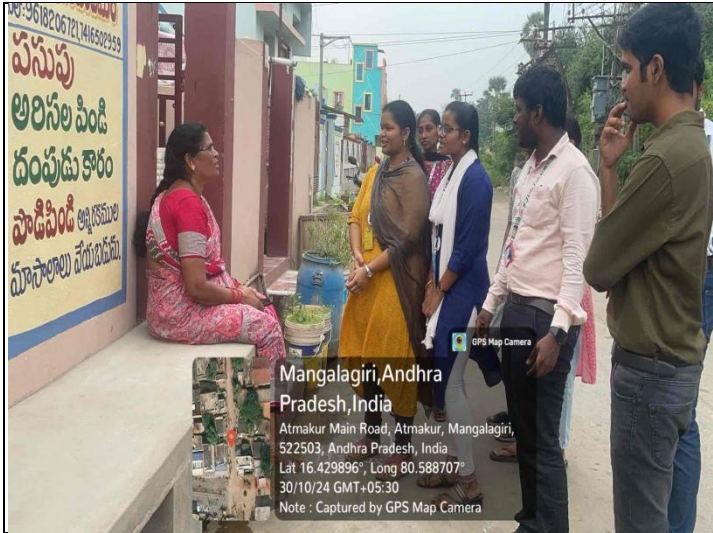
