

Description of the Event:

On November 12, 2024, KLEF - CEA launched an impactful door-to-door campaign aimed at raising awareness about electronic waste (e-waste) management within the community. Volunteers engaged with residents to educate them on the importance of responsible e-waste disposal, the environmental hazards posed by improper handling of electronic waste, and the benefits of recycling old electronics. The campaign featured informative brochures, interactive discussions, and demonstrations on how to properly recycle various electronic items. By fostering a sense of responsibility and encouraging sustainable practices, KLEF - CEA sought to empower individuals to make informed decisions about their electronic waste, contributing to a cleaner and healthier environment.

Objectives:

- **1. Raise Awareness:** To educate residents about e-waste, including its definition, types, and the increasing volume of e-waste generated in households.
- 2. Highlight Health and Environmental Risks: To inform the community about the health hazards and environmental damage caused by improper disposal of electronic waste, such as toxic materials leaking into the soil and water.
- **3. Promote Safe Disposal Practices:** To provide information on safe disposal methods and local recycling options available for electronic waste, encouraging residents to utilize these services.
- **4. Encourage Responsible Consumer Behavior:** To inspire individuals to make informed purchasing decisions regarding electronics, including considerations for durability, repair ability, and recycling.
- 5. Foster Community Engagement: To actively involve community members in discussions about e-waste and its impact, promoting collective responsibility for managing electronic waste effectively.
- **6. Collaborate with Local Organizations:** To establish partnerships with local businesses, government agencies, and environmental organizations to create a network of support for e-waste management initiatives.

- 7. Collect Feedback and Data: To gather insights from residents about their current e-waste disposal practices, preferences, and awareness levels which can help shape future initiatives and campaigns.
- **8. Empower Action:** To motivate residents to take personal responsibility for their ewaste through actionable steps, such as organizing community collection events or participating in recycling programs.

Outcome:

The door-to-door awareness campaign on e-waste conducted by KLEF - CEA yielded significant positive outcomes within the community. Residents demonstrated a marked increase in understanding of e-waste and its environmental impacts, as evidenced by engaging discussions and inquiries during the campaign. Many participants expressed a willingness to adopt responsible disposal practices, with numerous households committing to recycling their old electronics at designated facilities. The campaign also successfully fostered community engagement, leading to the establishment of partnerships with local businesses and organizations to support ongoing e-waste management initiatives. Overall, the campaign not only raised awareness but also empowered residents to take action, contributing to a collective effort toward a more sustainable and environmentally conscious community.

Impact of the Society:
