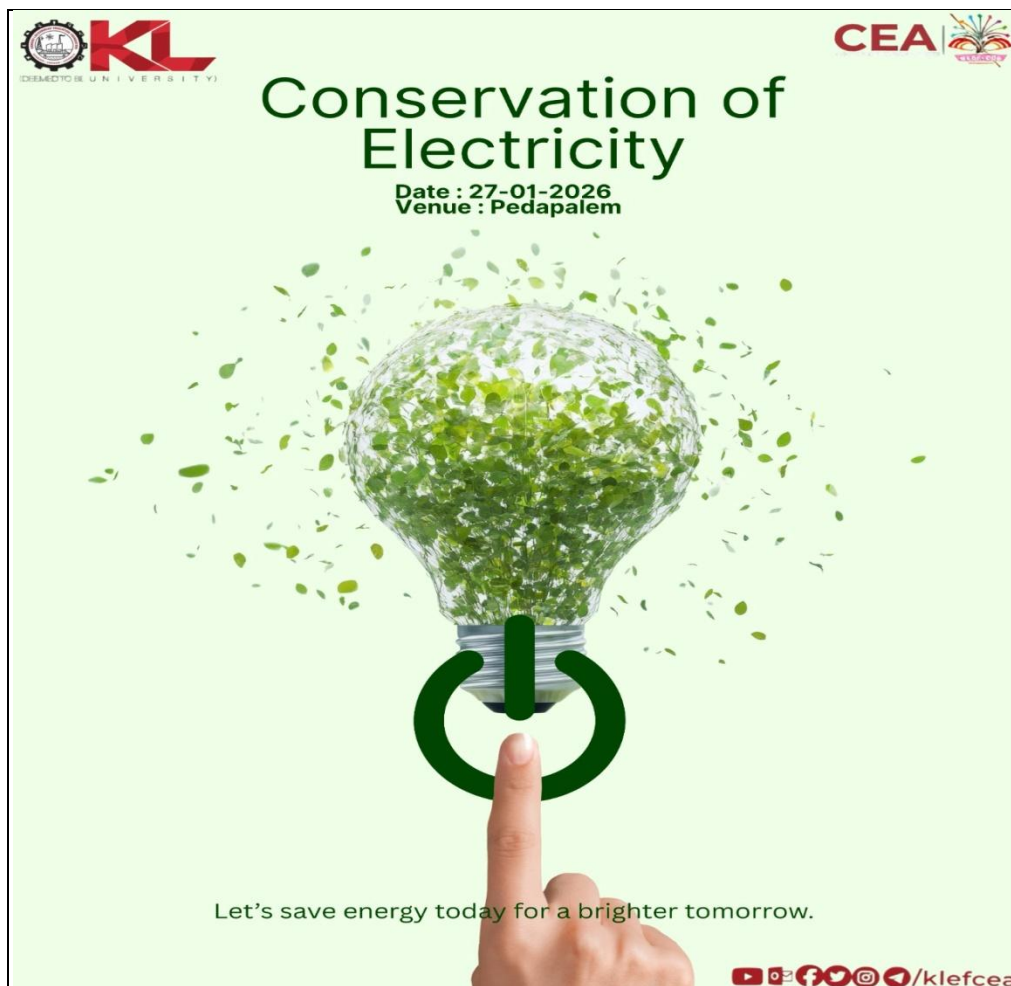

Description of the Event:

KLEF–Centre for Extension Activities (CEA), in association with the Department of CSE–2, jointly organised a “Conservation of Electricity” door-to-door awareness campaign on 27/01/2026 at Pedapalem Village.
