**Description of the Event:**

**Outcome:**

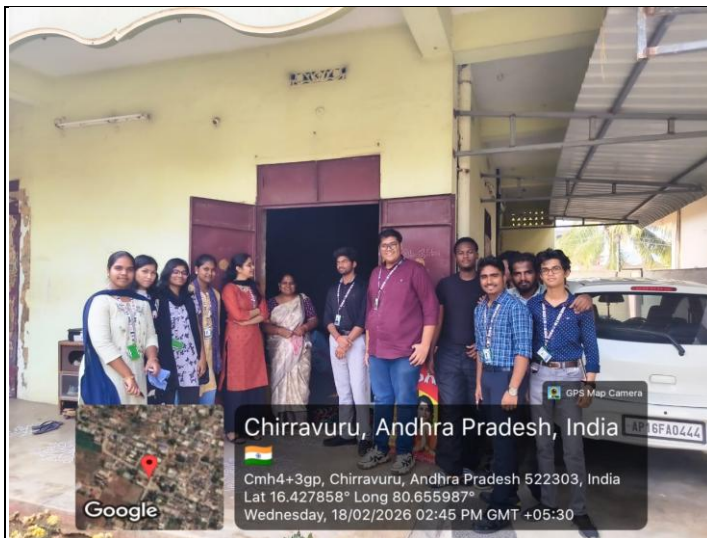
