

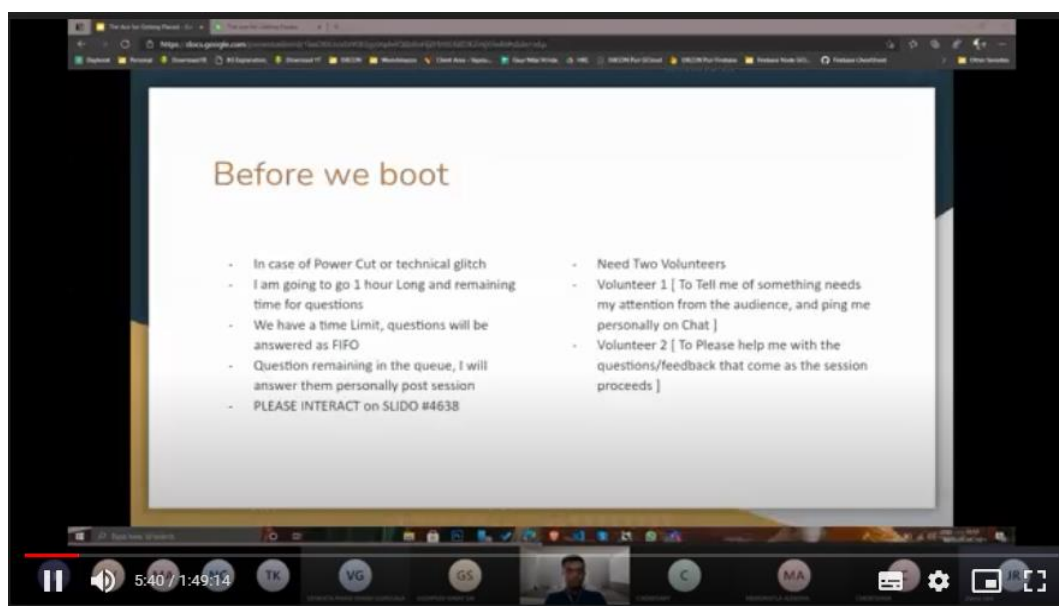
Guest Lecture Report on “A Career Orientation Talk for Computer Science”
