Objective:

The objective of Awareness on Seasonal Diseases during the Swachh Bharat initiative is to promote public health by linking cleanliness practices with disease prevention. It aims to educate communities on how maintaining cleanliness and proper sanitation can reduce the spread of seasonal illnesses. This effort seeks to encourage responsible hygiene behaviors that align with the Swachh Bharat mission, ultimately leading to a healthier, cleaner society.

Description:

Mr. P. Srikanth Reddy, the NSS Program Coordinator at KL Deemed University, emphasized the collective responsibility of villagers to maintain cleanliness to prevent health issues. Participating in a Swachh Bharat program organized by the ECE department of NSS in Praturu village, Tadepalli Rural, on Saturday, he urged residents to keep their homes and surroundings clean and to dispose of garbage in rickshaws instead of on drains and roads. Praturu Gram Panchayat Secretary Mr. Srinivasa Rao highlighted the risks of mosquito breeding in stagnant water, warning of diseases like dengue, malaria, and chikungunya. He advised villagers to take precautions against mosquito bites, consume fresh food, and seek medical attention if a fever persists for more than three days. The event saw participation from university officials, including Vice Chancellor Dr. G. Pardhasaradhi Varma, Pro Vice Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad and Dr. N. Venkatram, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Dean of Student Affairs Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, Advisor Dr. Habibullah Khan, Principal Dr. T.K. Ramakrishna Rao, and other volunteers, with NSS Coordinator Mr. P.Suresh overseeing the program.

Outcome:

The event resulted in heightened community awareness about the critical link between cleanliness and health, leading villagers to adopt better hygiene and waste disposal practices. It reduced the risk of diseases like dengue and malaria by addressing potential mosquito breeding sites. The participation of university officials and volunteers further strengthened the relationship between the institution and the local community, encouraging ongoing collaboration for public health initiatives.

Impact on Society:

The event had a positive societal impact by promoting a cleaner, healthier environment in Praturu village, thereby reducing the spread of mosquito-borne diseases. It empowered the community to take collective responsibility for their surroundings, fostering a culture of proactive public health practices. The initiative also highlighted the importance of educational institutions in driving social change and improving community well-being.
