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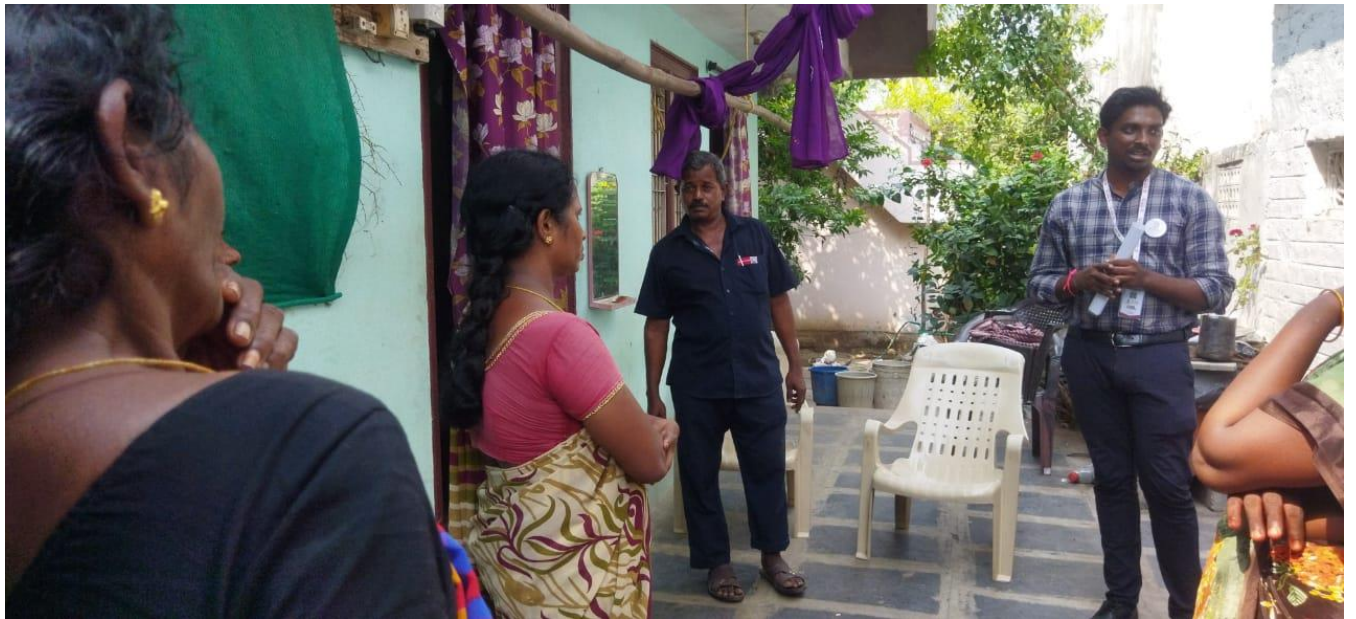
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Report on Exposure and Field Visit for Problem Identification

The program is a part of ACIC KL Startups Foundation outreach events as per the project submitted to Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) under ACIC activities by KLEF Deemed to be University. The primary objective is to create awareness on ACIC incubation center to promote self sustainable opportunities for the community belonging to Textile industry of Mangalagiri area. In addition to that the student community belonging to our university

Textile Art: It is an art form using textile materials as its medium. The definition of textile art is a general term that includes fiber art, knitwear, woven fabric, and embroidery. The possible subject matter of textile art ranges from the representation of images and figures to abstract shapes and patterns. The types of materials used in textile arts include cloth, yarn, fiber, string, thread, or wire fabric. If a material is not fixed to another object that can move or be deformed it is considered a freeform material. As for materials used in the production of textile art, cotton is one of the most common fibers made from plants. This can be spun into thread or yarn to be used for cloth making. Fibers such as wool are usually made from animal hair such as sheep or goat (which can also be called "wool"). Silk is a type of protein fiber produced by silkworms that grows on spindles in their stomachs. Recycled fibers like hemp are also becoming popular in today's society due to its biodegradable nature. Textile art can be created using different materials such as cotton, silk, or wool. Today, the use of synthetic fabrics has made textile artists more creative than ever before. The textile arts can be thought of as a medium for creating, understanding, and communicating cultural values through the use of textiles. Textile artists have been creating a wide variety of artistic pieces around the world since humankind's earliest history. The history of textile art dates back to ancient civilizations; it has been around for more than 10,000 years and has been used to create many different things such as clothing, religious artifacts, weapons, and more.

Textile design in Mangalagiri area was mainly about dyeing, weaving and sewing. In a sense, it was an extension of already existing forms of material culture they use in this area (Mainly cotton type). But with the advent of industrial technologies and mass-production techniques, textile design became more elaborate and abstract.
