Dr. B. Loveswara Rao, Professor, EEE Department has given a welcome note. The resource person explained the importance of Data Engineering for Electrical engineering students for getting a high package in campus drives. Students' priority as of the trends in the software field should be to learn either topics related to data (data science/data engineering) or cybersecurity.

There is a lot of hype about data science as even a non-engineering student can learn it but the real deal lies in learning data engineering first as it will teach the learner everything related to 'data' which is strongly related to real-life scenarios. Data engineers solve 'real world problems' (data can be anything from health, finance, environmental trends, etc).

Students must obtain at least the first level of cloud certification for getting better placements. (I would suggest to go with Microsoft Azure).

Coming to cybersecurity is as interesting as your career advances in this field. Starting in this field can be a bit boring compared to the data-related fields but cybersecurity engineers have better chances of working for the government.

Also, irrespective of the field the student gets into, he/she should invest 10 to 20 percent of their in-hand salary in various investment opportunities like stocks, mutual funds, bonds, and health/life insurance as it will help them retire comfortably and peacefully.
