National Practicum on English Language Teaching in India: Issues, Debates and Strategies held at KLUniversity.

One – day National practicum on English Language Teaching in India: Issues, Debates and Strategies was organized by the Department of English KLUniversity on the 10th of December, 2012. Professor M.Rajeshwar, the eminent academician of Kakatiya University has steered the session by focusing his argument on the technology based English Language Teaching.
