### WQD Theme for 2022: Quality conscience: Doing the right thing

This is to inform that Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) & Academic Staff College (ASC) are jointly conducting the following events on the occasion of **"World Quality Day – 2022"**.

1. Organizing a Workshop on the WQD 2022 with the theme **"Quality conscience: Doing the right thing"** for all the faculty members of KLEF from 9.30 am to 5.00 pm on **10<sup>th</sup> November, 2022** (Thursday).
2. Conducting Essay Writing, Elocution, Poster presentation and Quiz competitions.
3. **Essay Writing Contest:** Students have to write an essay of not less than 500 words within 45 minutes on one of the 17 Topics given in the Annexure. Venue is C202. The topic will be given at the venue. Students will have Max. 4 choices to ask for change of topic but as decided by the Examiner. The time slot is during 1 pm – 2 pm on any of the following days: (i) 29-10-2022 (Saturday), (ii) 31-10-2022 (Monday), (iii) 02-11-2022 (Wednesday) and (iv) 04-11-2022 (Friday).
4. **Elocution Contest:** Students can choose any one of the themes provided in the Annexure and prepare a 5-minute video and mail to [igacoffice@kluniversity.in](mailto:igacoffice@kluniversity.in) on or before 6<sup>th</sup> November 2022 (Sunday).
5. **Poster Presentation:** Students can prepare a poster and submit at IQAC on any one of the following 6 themes of United Nations Self Development Goals:
  - Good Health and Well-being
  - Quality Education
  - Gender Equality
  - Decent Work and Economic Growth
  - Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure
  - Reduced Inequality
6. **Quiz competition:** Quiz competition will be conducted during 2-3 pm on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2022 during the WQD 2022 Celebrations. Those who couldn't participate on 10-11-2022 may appear for Quiz Competition from 4-5 pm on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2022 (Friday) at C-202. The quiz shall comprise of 20 questions relating to various quality parameters in Higher Education Institutions. Time: 20 minutes.
7. **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Prizes will be given for all Winners.** Prize-winners shall be intimated before 12 Noon on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2022 (except Quiz). Certificates will be issued to all participants.
8. World Quality Day 2022 Program will be announced next week.
