


DECEMBER 2024:

- Approached University of Strasbourg France for a tie-up. They responded positively indicating that they are keen to interact with our team offering Robotics and Automation. Dr. Rooban, our expert on Robotics and Automation has been asked to take the cue from us and to move forward by getting in touch with his peers in the University.
- Profile of Dr. Hashila from UPM Serdang, Selangor who is an agri Scientist – was shared with the department of Agriculture and Biotechnology- both have said that she shall not be useful to their departments.
- Approached MMSU, Philippines and APU Malaysia requesting them to allocate co-supervisors for our Ph.D Students.
- Working on getting the co supervisors for our research scholars with all the partner Universities. Interacted with 9 Universities. Three of them have already completed the task. Informed our R&D wing on this. This **coordination has been assigned by the Dean R&D to Dr. Ahmad, Dy Director of R&D and work is in hand.**
- With an intention to re-establish severed connections with University of Macau, we invited professors of NLP and ML – Dr. Derek F Wong and Dr. Lidia Sam Chao to visit us. Sent invitations to them. But their **Visa application was rejected by the Indian Embassy at Hong Kong** asking them to resubmit along with clearance from Indian Ministry of Home and Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- Campaigned among 2nd year students and 3rd year students on Semester Abroad Program that is being offered by numerous universities abroad. Total of 46 applications were received. As per the choice of the students, all the partner university International Offices have been approached with the academic credentials of the students.
- Applications to INTI International : 07 students (05 from Hyderabad and 02 from Vaddeswaram Campus) have filed their applications for Visa. Visa Approval letter from the immigration authorities of Malaysia is awaited and is expected by first week of January. Students shall be joining the Semester from 12th Jan 2025.
- Process is in hand – to send 3 students to Universiti Malaya and 4 students to MUST, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia under Semester Abroad Program – in pipeline
