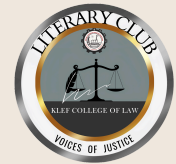

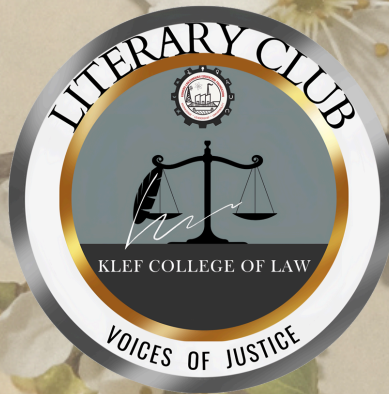

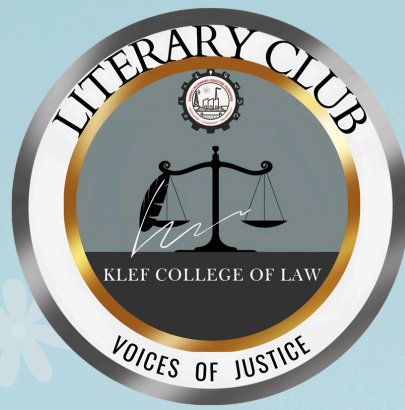

### Rounds:

- **Round 1:** Written Round - 50 words, 25 minutes.
- **Round 2:** Rapid Fire - Spell as many words as possible in 90 seconds.
- **Round 3:** Buzzer Round - Compete to spell 10 challenging words.

### Scoring:

- Written Round: +1 for correct, 0.5 for incorrect.
- Rapid Fire: +1 for correct, no negative marking.
- Buzzer Round: +5 for correct, 3 for incorrect, +2 bonus for missed words.
- Tie Breaker: Sudden death spell off in case of a tie.

### Judging Panel:

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### STORY TELLING

#### Eligibility

- Open to students from classes 8th to 12th standards.
- Only individual participation is allowed.

#### Theme

- No specific theme. Participants are free to choose their own topics. Only English and Telugu language.

**Number of Entries-** One story per participant.

#### Word & Time Limit:

- The story should not exceed 2,500 words and 10 minutes for the presentation.

#### Props

- Minimal, simple props are allowed.

## Submission Format

- Typed in Times New Roman, font size 12, double spaced.
- Files should be submitted as PDF or DOC/DOCX files with a separate cover page containing the participant's full name, college/university, email address, contact number, story title, and word count.

## Originality

- Stories must be original and unpublished, with no prior awards in any competition. Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.

## Anonymity

- Submissions will be judged anonymously. No identifying information should be included in the story.

## Judging Criteria

- Creativity and originality.
- Relevance to the chosen theme.
- Clarity and expression.
- Engagement with the audience.

## Prizes

- The top three winners will receive prizes, and all participants will get certificates.



# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## POETRY COMPETITION

- Open to students from classes 8th to 12th standards.
- Only individual participation is allowed.

### Theme

- No specific theme. Participants are free to choose their own topics.
- One poem per participant.

### Line & Time Limit

- Poems should not exceed 40 lines.
- Recitation should be within 15 minutes, with a grace period of 30 seconds for smooth recitation.

### Language

- Poems can be submitted and recited in any language.

### Presentation

- Both free verse and rhymed poetry are allowed. Participants may read from paper without penalty, though memorization is encouraged.

### Submission Format

- Typed in Times New Roman, font size 12, singles paced.
- Files should be submitted as PDF or DOC/DOCX files with a separate cover page containing the participant's full name, college/university, email address, contact number, poem title, and line count.

### Originality

- Poems must be original and unpublished, with no prior awards in any competition. Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.

### Judging Criteria

- Content and originality.
- Relevance to the chosen theme.
- Delivery and expression.
- Use of literary devices.

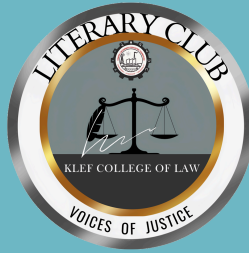

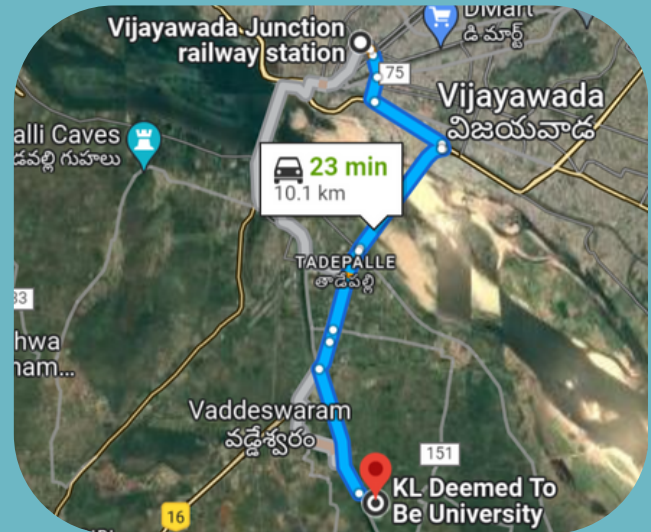
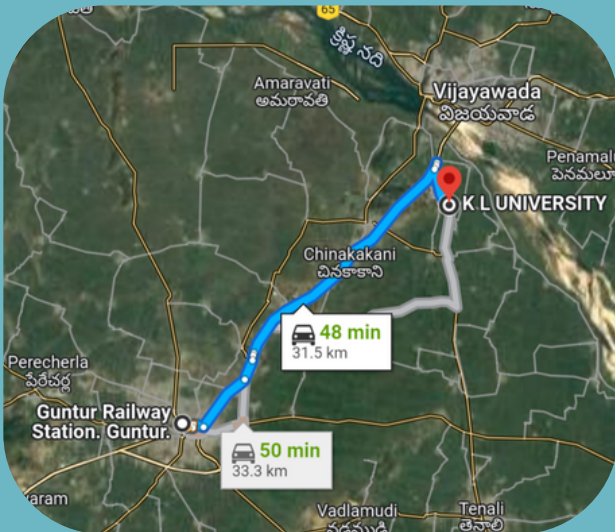
