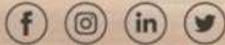

Constitution Day Celebrations

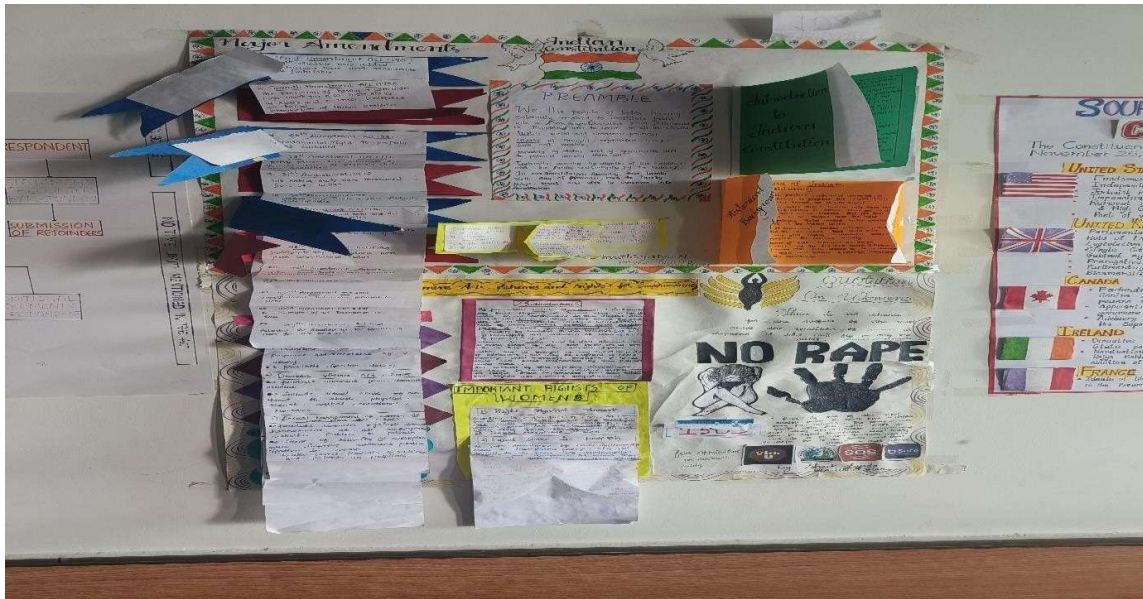
