




DAY 1: Inventory Optimization





- Inventory record accuracy in warehousing.




DAY 4: Trade-offs in Transportation

Churna illustrated the role of natural remedies in promoting wellness.






















SUMMER INTERNSHIP SUCCESS MEET FOR MBA STUDENTS AT KLBS

In addition to the physical benefits, Sports Day serves as a vital platform for students to practice leadership, collaboration, and strategic thinking—skills essential in business settings. Friendly







As our MBA department is organising Sports Day on 26th October 2024, I request all the faculty to join in all the events and be along with students to ensure discipline among the students.

It is basically intended to promote the physical activity among students and faculty and take a step with students to interact and motivate them.






KL Business School (KLBS) recently conducted a workshop on the Case Study Methodology to deepen students' analytical skills and understanding of realworld business issues. This interactive workshop introduced MBA students and faculty to the case study approach, widely regarded as a practical tool for bridging theoretical knowledge with practical application in management education. Facilitated by seasoned educators and industry professionals, the workshop covered essential aspects of analyzing and discussing complex cases, including problem identification, stakeholder analysis, decisionmaking, and strategic thinking.



April - June 2024 46 Participants were guided through various types of case studies, such as exploratory, explanatory, and descriptive cases, to understand their different uses and applications. Hands-on sessions allowed students to work in groups to dissect cases, brainstorm solutions, and present their findings, fostering teamwork and diverse perspectives. The facilitators also provided techniques for structuring case discussions, formulating insightful questions, and effectively communicating recommendations.


