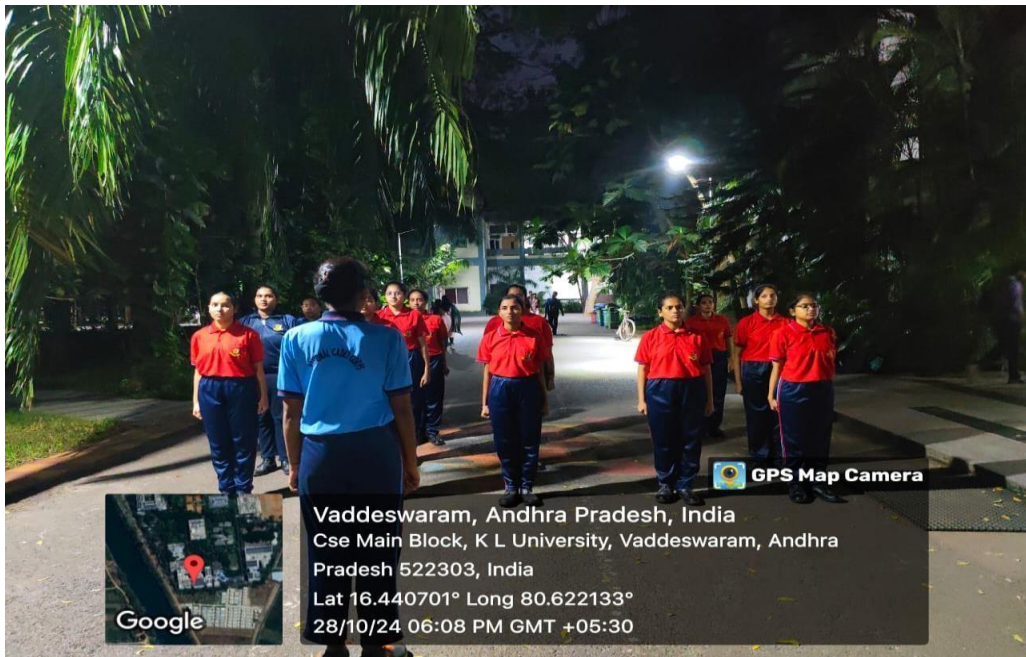
Conclusion: -

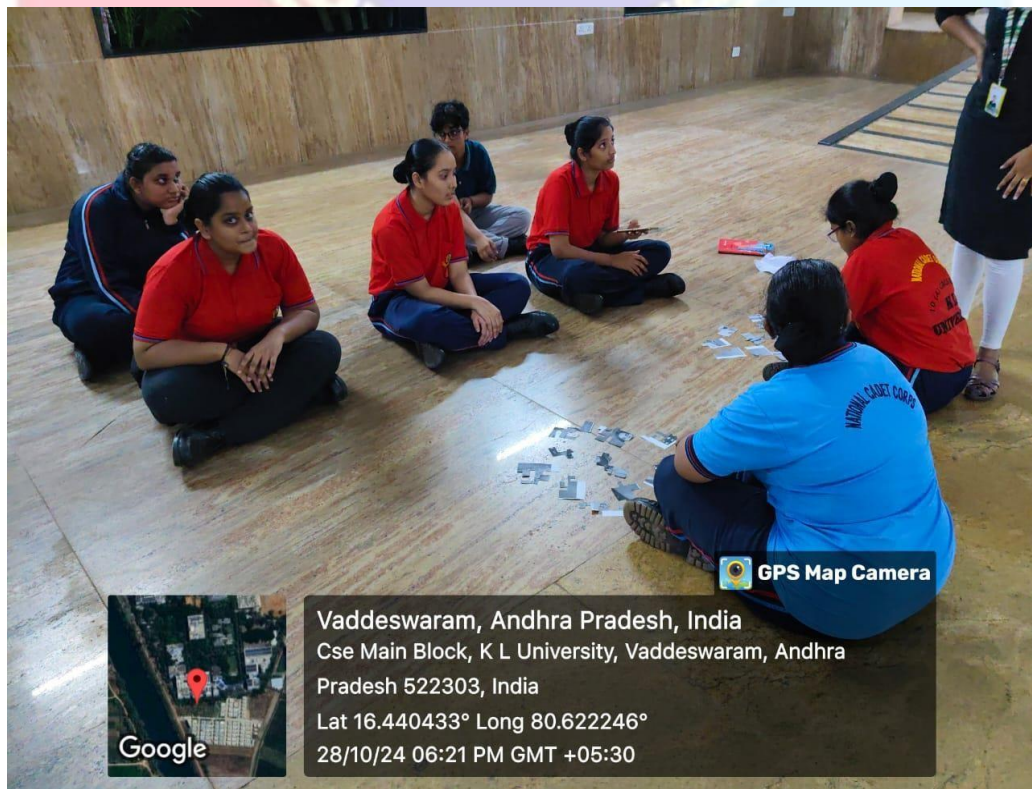

On October 28, 2024, the cadets devised the puzzle through the application of intellectual capacity.



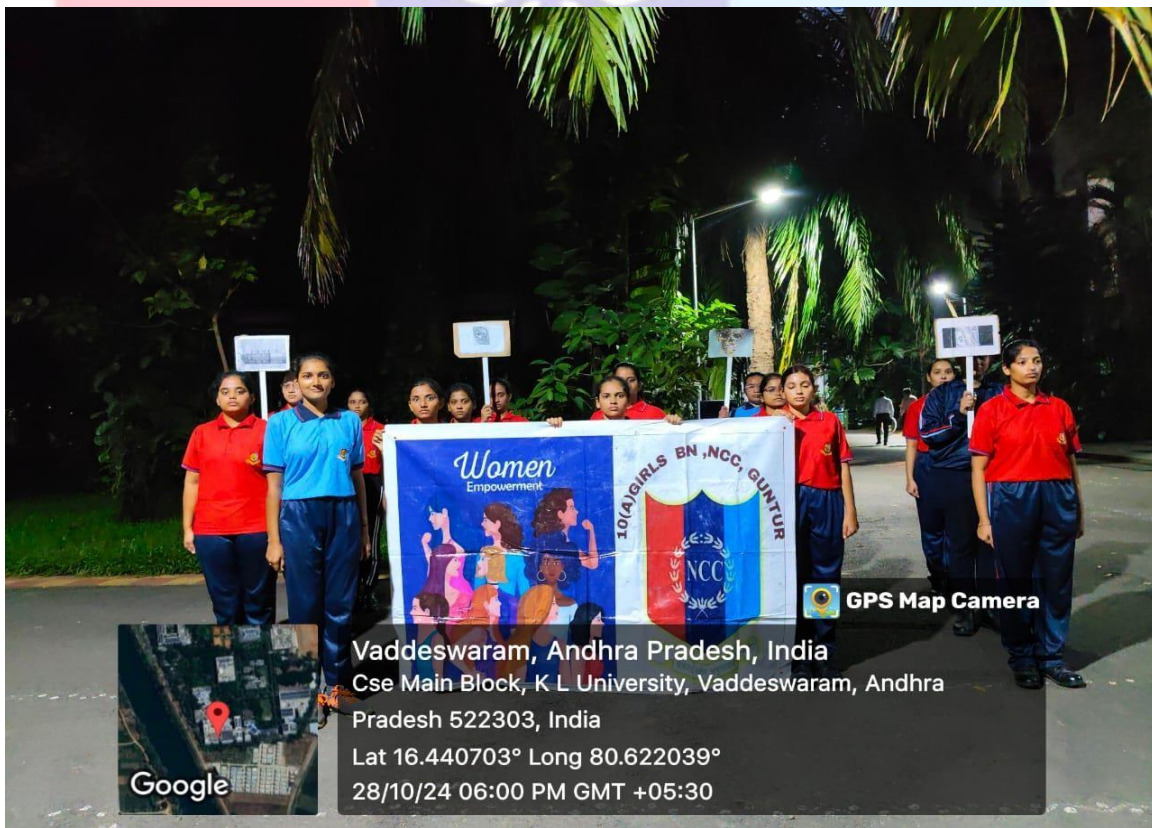
