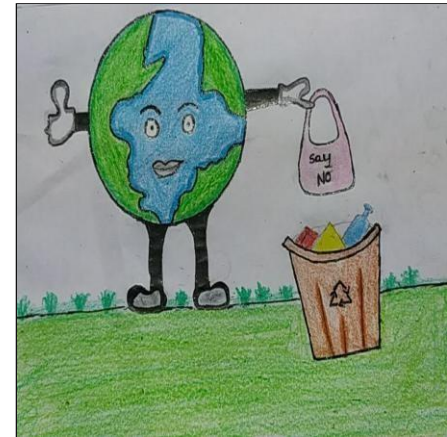
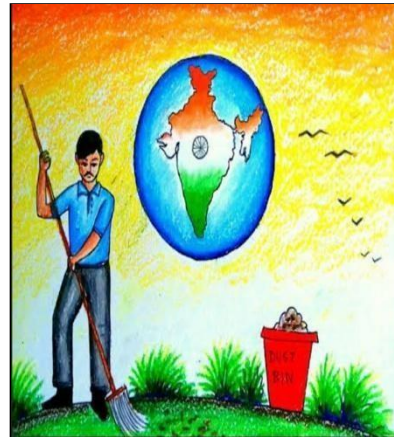
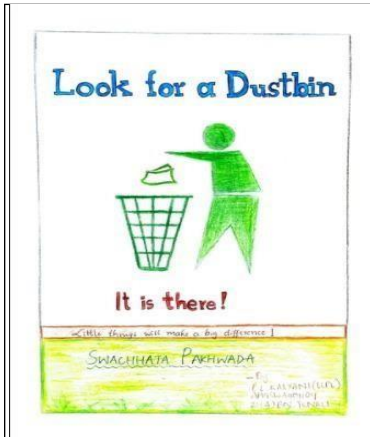
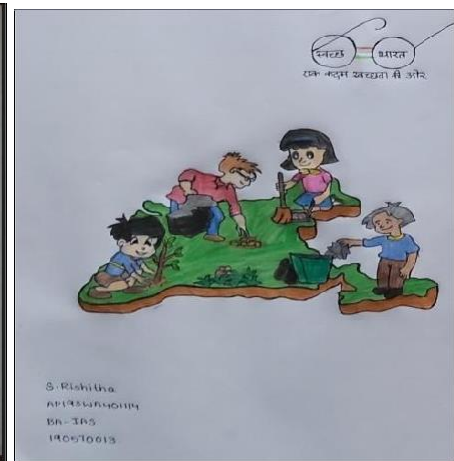
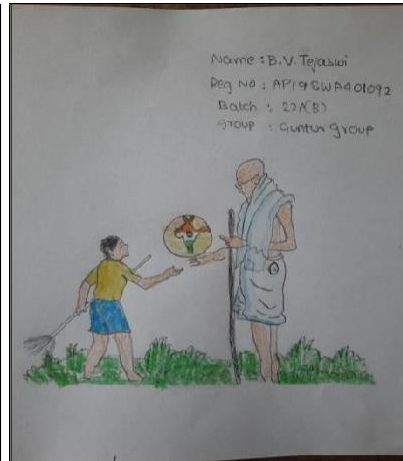
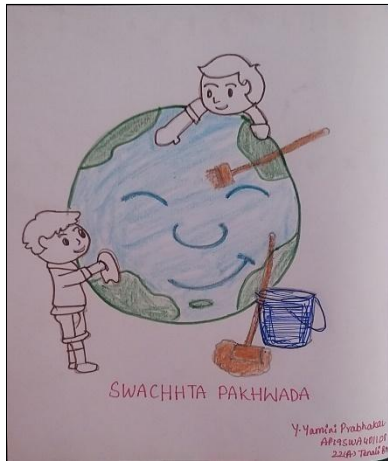
The key objectives of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan include :
