### **SEAT BELT AND HELMET AWARENESS ON THE DAY OF VIJAY DIWAS**

Victory Day is a significant national holiday in Bangladesh, celebrated on 16 December each year. The day holds great historical and emotional importance as it commemorates the defeat of the Pakistan Armed Forces and the subsequent independence of Bangladesh. The holiday marks the culmination of the Bangladesh Liberation War in 1971 and the official secession of East Pakistan, which later became the new state of Bangladesh.

During the nine-month-long Bangladesh Liberation War, the Pakistani forces committed numerous atrocities, including the 1971 Bangladeshi genocide. The war finally came to an end with the signing of the Pakistani Instrument of Surrender. General AAK Niazi, the commander of the Pakistani forces, surrendered to the Mukti Bahini, the Bangladeshi freedom fighters, and their Indian allies. This momentous event is remembered and commemorated on Victory Day. India, being a close neighbor and a significant participant in the liberation war, also celebrates Victory Day. In India, it is known as "Vijay Diwas" and serves as an occasion to honor the sacrifices made by both Indian and Bangladeshi soldiers who fought bravely during the war. It symbolizes the strong bond between the two nations and their shared history.

In commemoration of Victory Day, the cadets of KL University's 22(A) BN, Tenali organized a rally to pay tribute to the fallen soldiers of the Bangladesh Liberation War. The rally focused on two important themes: "Swachata hi Seva" (cleanliness is service) and "Road Safety Awareness." The cadets actively participated in the event, making it a resounding success. During the rally, the cadets chanted slogans to raise awareness about road safety, emphasizing the importance of following traffic rules and ensuring the well-being of all road users. Additionally, they distributed flowers to vehicle owners, spreading the message of road safety and fostering a sense of responsibility among the community.




