#### **NCC 'C' Certificate Examination:**

'C' Certificate is awarded to SD/SW Cadets of colleges after the completion of 3 years training course and passing 'C' Cert examination conducted for it. NCC cadet who has attended 75% of NCC parades, passed 'B' Cert examination and attended the Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) is eligible to appear in this examination. The examination is held in the month of Feb/Mar every year.

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) 'C' Certificate Examination is a significant milestone for cadets, representing the culmination of their training and dedication. The 'C' Certificate is the highest recognition awarded by the NCC and offers numerous advantages to its holders.

#### **Conduct of the Examination:**

The 'C' Certificate Examination typically comprises both written and practical assessments designed to evaluate a cadet's knowledge, skills, and physical fitness. Eligibility criteria for appearing in this examination include:

- Possession of 'B' Certificate: Cadets must have previously obtained the 'B' Certificate.
- Training Tenure: Cadets should be in their third year of Senior Division/Senior Wing NCC Training.
- Attendance: A minimum of 75% attendance in the third-year syllabus during the academic session is mandatory.
- Camps: Cadets must have attended one Annual Training Camp and, in addition, one of the following during their three-year tenure: National Integration Camp (NIC), Republic Day Camp (RDC), Centrally Organised Camp (COC), or Attachment with Regular Army/Navy/Air Force units.

It's important to note that the examination scheduled for February 18, 2024, was canceled due to a paper leak.

## Pupulse:

### Benefits of the 'C' Certificate:

Holding an NCC 'C' Certificate offers several tangible benefits, particularly for those aspiring to join the Indian Armed Forces and other government services:

- Direct SSB Interview: 'C' Certificate holders are exempted from the written examination for the Indian Army's Soldier General Duty (GD) recruitment and are directly eligible for the Service Selection Board (SSB) interview.

## NCC LNCT:

- Bonus Marks in Paramilitary Forces: Candidates with an NCC 'C' Certificate receive additional marks during recruitment in paramilitary forces such as the Border Security Force (BSF), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), and Sa shastra Seema Bal (SSB).

## NCC LNCT:

- Preference in State Services: Several state governments provide preferences or reservations for 'C' Certificate holders in their recruitment processes, especially in police services.

## GKV:

- Exemptions in Defense Examinations: Cadets with a 'C' Certificate and a minimum 'A' or 'B' grade are exempted from appearing in the Combined Defense Services (CDS) examination conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and can directly appear for the SSB interview.

## NCC LNCT:

- Reservations in Indian Navy and Air Force: The Indian Navy reserves a certain number of vacancies for 'C' Certificate holders in officer cadet entries, and the Indian Air Force provides additional marks for such candidates during the selection process.

## NCC LNCT:

In addition to these benefits, 'C' Certificate holders are often given preference in various public and private sector jobs, including roles in security services and educational institutions. The certificate signifies discipline, leadership, and a commitment to national service, qualities highly valued across multiple professions.

## BENEFITS OF 'C' CERTIFICATE:

- For ORs, Sailors, Airmen: 5 to 10 percent bonus marks awarded for recruitment.
  - Para Military Forces: 2 to 10 bonus marks awarded for recruitment
  - Department of telecommunication: Bonus marks awarded for recruitment
  - CRPF: NCC cadets holding 3rd division degree eligible for recruitment to gazetted posts.
  - NCC: Civilian Gliding instructors/Girl Cadet Instructors/ Whole Time Lady Officers.
  - State Govts: Preference for State Services in certain States.
  - Industry: Some industries give preference to NCC C certificate holders for various jobs related with the field of security.
  - NCC Games: Cash awards to teams and individuals for excellence.
- \* But for this, the cadet must have 'A' or 'B' grade in 'C' certificate. NCC 'C' certification offers you 10–15 bonus marks in paramilitary forces recruitment i.e. BSF, CISF, CRPF, SSB etc. If you have NCC 'C' certificates then your written exam will be waived off for the post of Soldier GD.
- \* The NCC 'C' certificate holds immense value, it serves like a X factor in various fields related to career, we are giving you an account of all the benefits the certificate holds in the sub headings below, so you can see how good it is to be a NCC 'C' certificate holder. Candidates with NCC 'C' certificate who wish to apply for General Duty (GD) and Tradesman (TDN) are exempted from appearing for the examination and those who wish to apply for Soldier (CLK/SKT/Tech/NA) they will get 15 marks.
