The 'B' Certificate holds significant value, particularly in the context of selection procedures for the Indian Defence Services and Civil Services. The certificate not only showcases a cadet's dedication and proficiency in NCC activities but also provides a competitive edge during recruitment processes for these esteemed services.

The 'B' Certificate Practical and Written Examination - February 2024

- **Weapon Drill:** This test was designed to assess the cadets' handling and operation of standard issue weapons. Proficiency in weapon drills is indicative of a cadet's readiness for more advanced training and operational duties.

The written exam, held on February 4th, further tested the theoretical knowledge acquired during NCC training. The combination of practical and written assessments ensures that cadets are well-rounded in both practical skills and theoretical understanding.
