Here are some outcomes of single-use plastic:

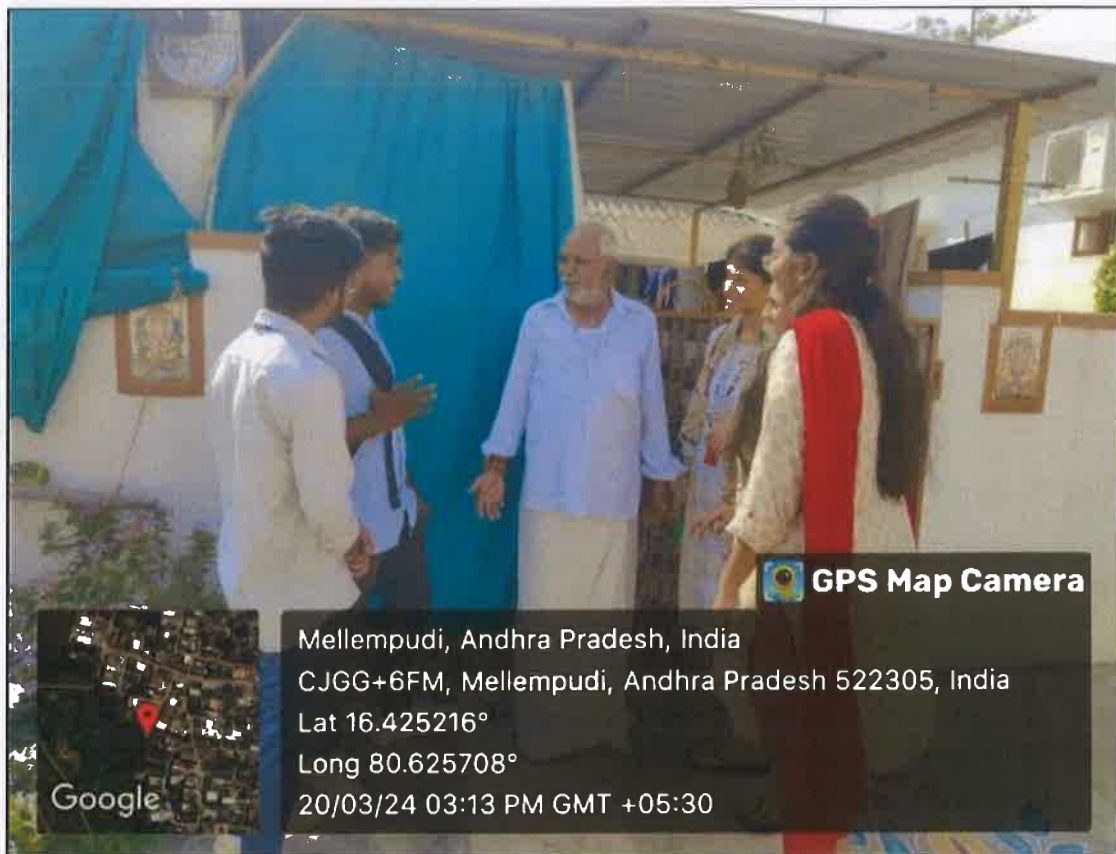
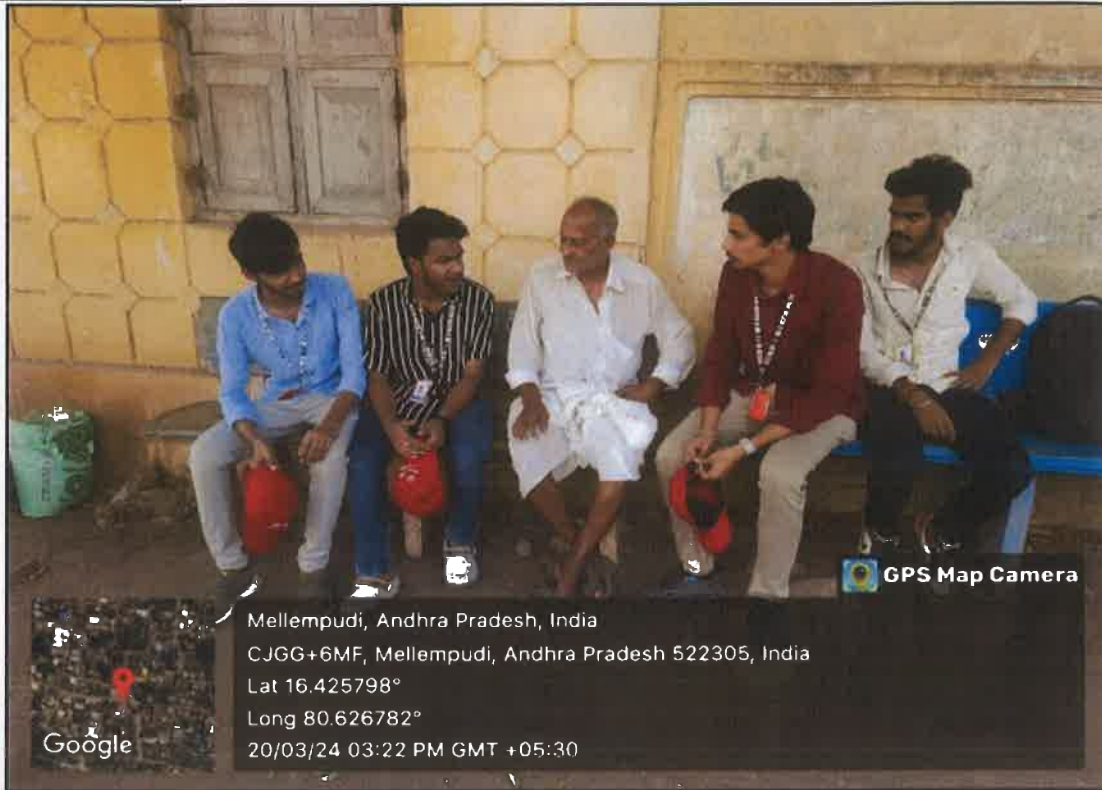
- Environmental pollution: Single-use plastic products take hundreds of years to decompose, leading to pollution of land, water, and air.
