How to make oral rehydration solution (ORS)


- ① Wash your hands with soap and treated water. 
- ② Wash container and stirring utensil with soap and treated water. 
- ③ Put 1 liter of treated water in the clean container. Put ORS powder in the water. 
Stir the solution with the clean utensil.
- ④ 
1 liter bottle


How to use oral rehydration solution (ORS)

Give ½ liter of ORS each day to babies and toddlers who have diarrhea. 

Give 1 liter of ORS each day to children who have vomiting or diarrhea. 

Go to the clinic as soon as you can. Give your child more oral rehydration solution (ORS) or breast milk on the way. 

Give 3 liters of ORS each day to adults who have vomiting or diarrhea. 

Go to the clinic as soon as you can. Drink more oral rehydration (ORS) on the way.

Objective:

To enhance diarrhea disease awareness about the KLEF College of Pharmacy Unit-06 Team National Service Scheme (NSS) has Conducted Awareness diarrhea disease at Mellampudi Village on 21-03-2024 as part of Special Camp.

Description:

Diarrhea is a gastrointestinal condition characterized by loose, watery stools and an increased frequency of bowel movements. It can be caused by a variety of factors such as Bacterial, Viral or Parasitic Infections, Food intolerance, certain medications, or underlying medical conditions.

Some common symptoms of Diarrhea include:

- Nausea and vomiting
- Fever
- Dehydration
- Fatigue
- Loss of appetite
- Blood or mucus in stool

Procedure of the Event:

6. The village-wide event concluded with participants gaining a comprehensive understanding of diarrhea disease, actively contributing to the promotion of immunization for a healthier Mellempudi Village.

Outcome:

Diarrhea can lead to several outcomes, particularly if left untreated or if the underlying cause is not addressed. Here are some potential outcomes of diarrhea:

- Dehydration: Frequent watery stools can lead to a significant loss of fluids and electrolytes, resulting in dehydration. Severe dehydration can be life-threatening, especially in young children and elderly individuals.
- Malnutrition: Diarrhea can impair nutrient absorption, leading to malnutrition and weight loss, particularly in children and individuals with chronic diarrhea.
- Electrolyte imbalances: Frequent diarrhea can cause imbalances in electrolytes such as sodium, potassium, and chloride, which can affect various bodily functions.
- Skin breakdown: Prolonged exposure to diarrheal stool can cause skin irritation, inflammation, and breakdown, particularly in areas such as the buttocks and thighs.
- Complications: In some cases, diarrhea can lead to complications such as bowel perforation, toxic mega colon, or sepsis.
- Spread of infection: If the diarrhea is caused by an infectious agent, it can spread to others through contaminated food or water, or through person-to-person contact.

Overall, the Awareness on Diarrhea disease conducted by the KLEF team at Mellampudi Village on 21-03-2024 successfully concluded, contributing significantly to raising awareness on Diarrhea disease.

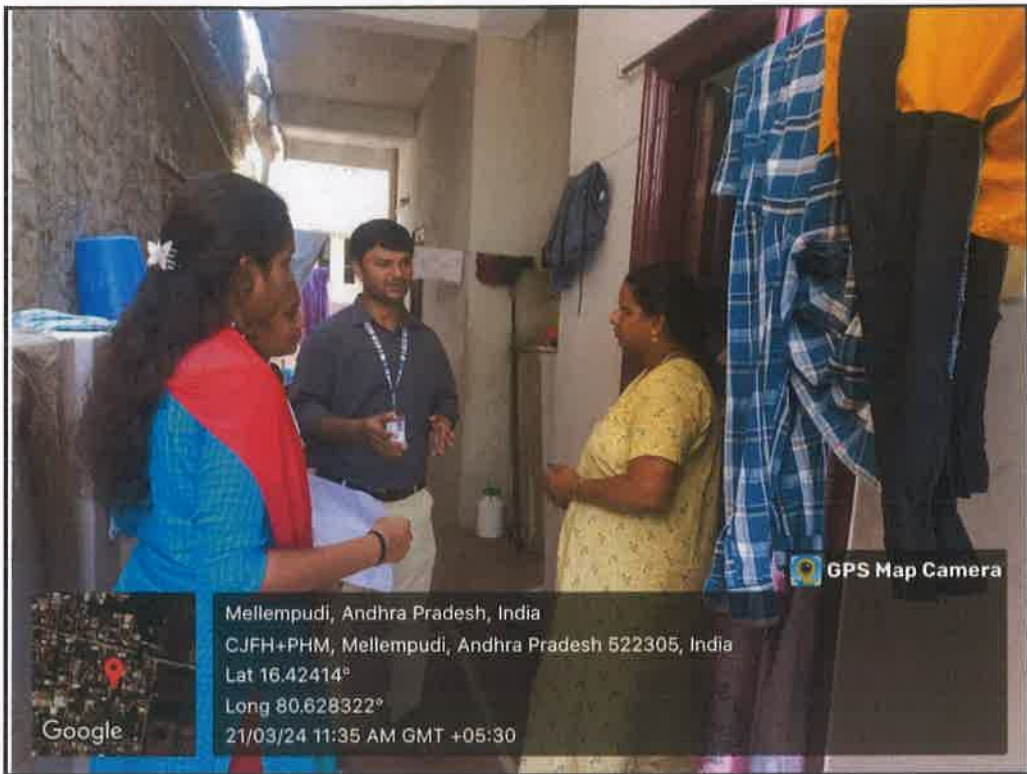
