Objective:

To enhance Awareness on Gender Sensitization, Koneru Lakshmaiah Education Foundation conducted an event in Mellampudi, in the form of Door to door on 22-03-2024.

Description:

5. Participants take notes on the feedback received from villagers, including questions asked, concerns raised and overall receptiveness.

The event concluded with the students, faculty and participants gaining a better understanding of awareness on Gender sensitization.

Outcome:

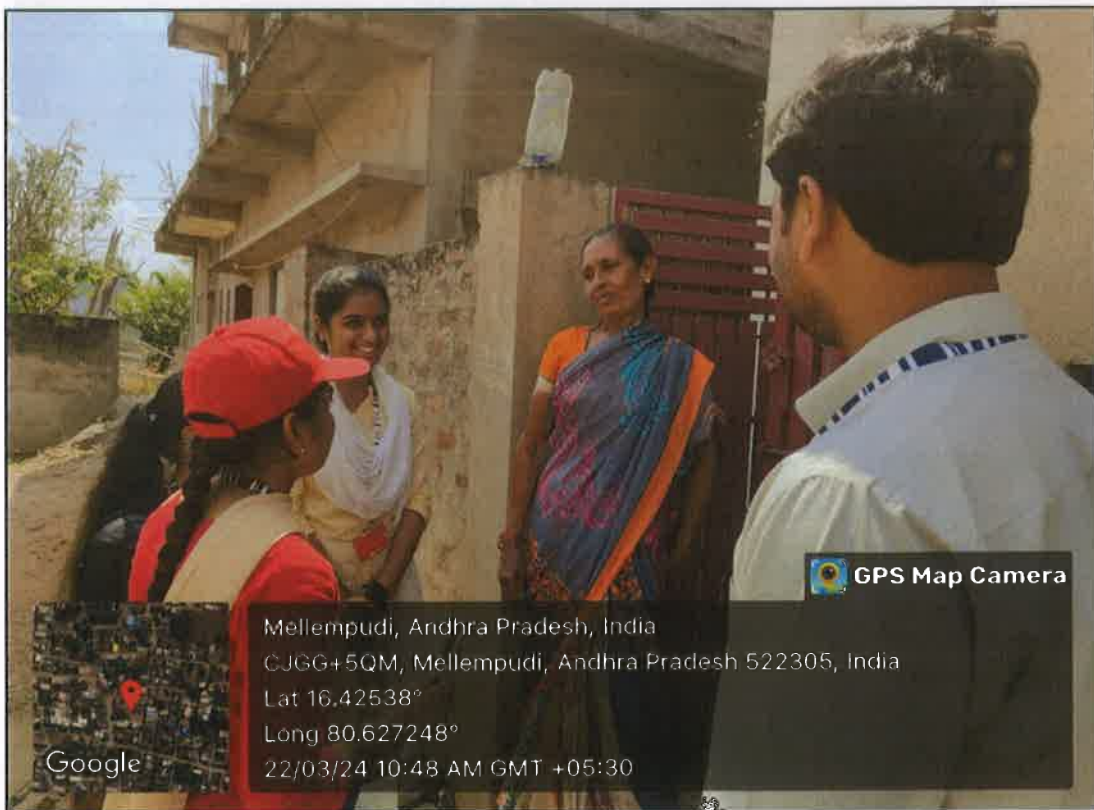

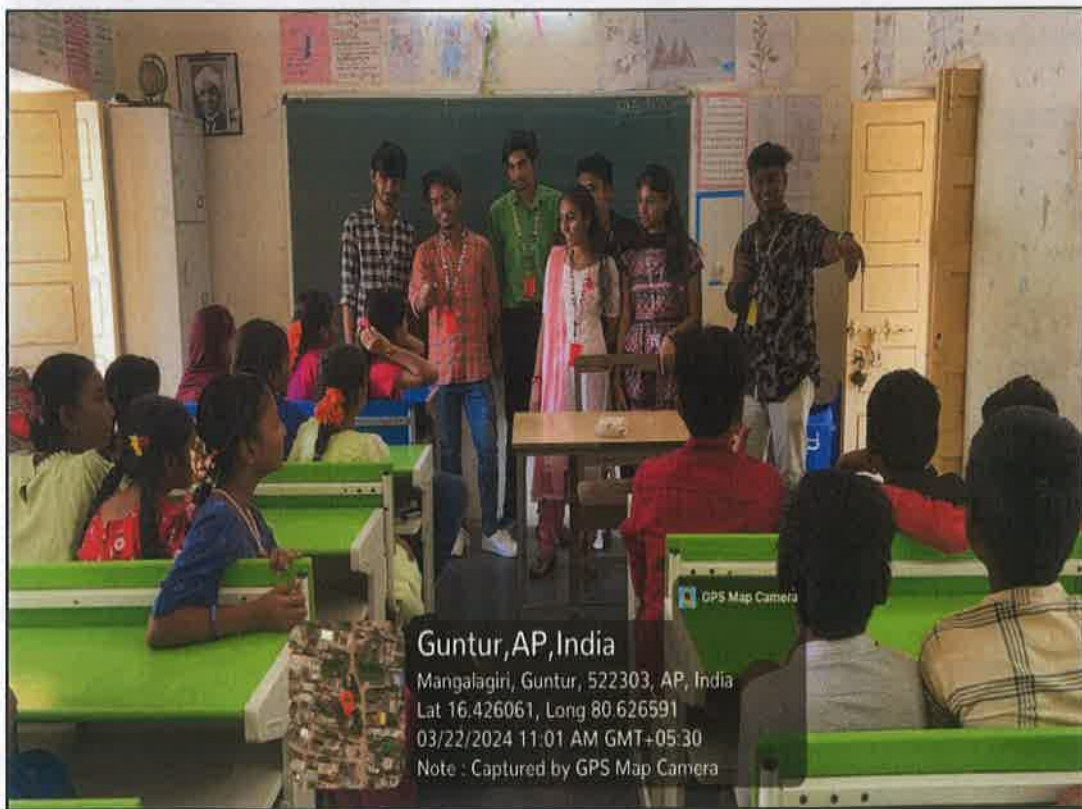
