





Objective:

The NSS Special Camp organized the Awareness to Smokeless Stoves event at Mellempudi village on 24-03-2024, aiming to foster health awareness and equip participants with knowledge about their blood types for emergency readiness.

Description:

A smokeless stove is a type of stove designed to burn fuel more efficiently and produces little to no smoke. These stoves typically use a secondary combustion system that burns off the smoke and gases produced during the initial combustion process, resulting in a cleaner and more complete burn. Some common features of smokeless stoves include:

- Double-walled construction: Smokeless stoves often have a double-walled design that helps to preheat the air entering the combustion chamber, promoting more efficient burning.
- Secondary combustion system: A secondary combustion system introduces additional air into the stove, allowing for the combustion of smoke and gases produced during the initial burn.
- High-temperature glass: Smokeless stoves often feature high-temperature glass doors that provide a clear view of the fire while preventing smoke from escaping.
- Efficient fuel use: Smokeless stoves are designed to burn fuel more efficiently, resulting in longer burn times and less fuel consumption compared to traditional stoves.
- Reduced emissions: By burning fuel more completely, smokeless stoves produce fewer emissions and particulates, making them a more environmentally friendly option.

Procedure of the Event:

- Volunteers visited households in Mellempudi village to Awareness on smokeless stove to villagers.
- 2. At each house, the volunteers performed the blood grouping test and explained its importance to the residents.
- Volunteers addressed any questions or concerns villagers had about the blood grouping test.
- Families were encouraged to participate in the blood grouping test at the nearest testing center.
- The event concluded with volunteers ensuring that every household understood the significance of the blood grouping test in maintaining good health.

Outcome:

Smokeless stoves can have several positive outcomes, including:

- Improved indoor air quality: By producing little to no smoke, smokeless stoves
 can significantly reduce indoor air pollution, leading to healthier indoor air
 quality and reducing respiratory problems associated with traditional stoves.
- Increased fuel efficiency: Smokeless stoves are designed to burn fuel more efficiently, resulting in less fuel consumption and lower heating costs.
- Reduced environmental impact: By burning fuel more completely and producing fewer emissions, smokeless stoves have a reduced impact on the environment compared to traditional stoves.
- Longer burn times: Smokeless stoves can often provide longer burn times, meaning less frequent refueling is required.
- Aesthetic appeal: Many smokeless stoves feature a modern, sleek design that can enhance the aesthetic appeal of a room.
- Reduced creosote buildup: By burning fuel more efficiently and completely, smokeless stoves can reduce creosote buildup in chimneys, reducing the risk of chimney fires.






