Objective:

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-5 of the AI&DS Department, KL University organized a “Campaign on Women & Girl Child Safety” on Saturday, 14th March 2026, in Ramachandrapuram village of Mangalagiri Mandal as part of the NSS Special Camp. Awareness was also created about safe travel, responsible use of social media, and basic self-defense techniques. He added that such initiatives play a key role in building a society where women and girls can live safely, confidently, and with dignity.

The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated for their efforts by University Vice-
