- LOTTERY & PRIZE SCAMS**: Fake prizes to trick you into sharing details.
- UPI & PAYMENT FRAUDS**: Requests for money or QR codes sent by strangers.

SMART TIPS TO STAY SAFE ONLINE

- DO NOT SHARE**: Never share OTP, PIN, passwords or banking details with anyone.
- CHECK BEFORE YOU CLICK**: Verify the website link and the sender before clicking on any link.
- USE STRONG PASSWORDS**: Create strong passwords and change them regularly.
- BUY ONLY FROM TRUSTED SITES**: Shop only on verified and trusted websites.
- BEWARE OF UNKNOWN CALLS**: Do not share personal or financial information on calls.
- REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY**: Report any fraud or suspicious activity to your bank or cyber crime helpline.

Objective:

The objective of the “Be Smart and Avoid Online Fraud” program is to create awareness about common cyber scams and fraudulent activities. It aims to educate people on safe online practices such as protecting personal information, avoiding suspicious links, and verifying sources. The program also encourages individuals to stay alert and report cyber crimes promptly. Overall, it promotes digital safety and helps build a secure and informed society.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-6 of the CS&IT Department, KL University organized an awareness program on “Be Smart and Avoid Online Fraud” on Monday, 16th March 2026, in Nuthakki village of Mangalagiri Mandal as part of the NSS Special Camp. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that raising awareness on online fraud has become highly important in today’s digital age.

Head of the CS&IT Department, Dr. A. V. Praveen Krishna, explained that with the increasing use of online banking, shopping, and mobile applications, cyber frauds have also risen significantly. He noted that cybercriminals use fake links, phishing messages, and fraudulent calls to steal personal information such as OTPs, PINs, and passwords, leading to financial loss. Hence, people must remain alert and cautious. NSS Program Coordinator, Dr. P. Srikant Reddy, advised people never to share OTPs or bank details with anyone, avoid trusting unknown calls or messages, and not to click on suspicious links. He also emphasized using trusted websites for online transactions, creating strong passwords, updating them regularly, and limiting the sharing of personal information on social media.

NSS Program Officer, Dr. N. Praveen, stated that in case of any fraud, individuals should immediately inform their bank or report to the cybercrime helpline. He highlighted that such awareness programs help reduce cybercrimes by promoting cautious behavior, and stressed the importance of spreading the message: “Think Before You Click – Stay Alert, Stay Safe.” The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated for their efforts by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, along with Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K.

Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Student Affairs Deans Dr. K.R.S. Prasad and Dr. Habibullah Khan, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.


