

**Objective:**

The objective of the Healthy Community, TB-Free Society program is to create awareness about tuberculosis prevention, early detection, and proper treatment. It aims to educate people about TB symptoms, hygiene practices, and the importance of completing medical treatment. The program also works to reduce stigma and encourage community support for affected individuals. Overall, it promotes public health and contributes to building a healthier, TB-free society.

**Description:**

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-2 of the CSE-2 Department, KL University organized an awareness program on “Healthy Community, TB-Free Society” on Tuesday, 31st March 2026, in Mellampudi village. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that the program aimed to educate villagers about Tuberculosis (TB), an infectious disease that primarily affects the lungs but can be completely cured if identified early and treated properly. He explained that TB spreads through the air when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks, making public awareness essential.

Head of the CSE-2 Department, Dr. B. Tirupati Reddy, informed villagers that symptoms such as cough lasting more than two weeks, fever, night sweats, weight loss, fatigue, and loss of appetite should not be ignored, and immediate testing at nearby health centers is necessary. He emphasized that early diagnosis can reduce disease severity and prevent transmission to others. He also stressed that TB patients must complete the full course of prescribed medication without interruption, as stopping treatment midway can worsen the disease and increase the risk of Drug-Resistant TB. He further informed villagers that the government provides free TB diagnosis and treatment services.

NSS Programme Officer, Dr. C.H. Nagamani, explained that preventive measures such as covering the mouth and nose while coughing or sneezing, ensuring proper ventilation and sunlight in homes, consuming nutritious food, and maintaining personal hygiene are essential in TB prevention. She also encouraged society not to discriminate against TB patients but to support them with care and awareness. Through the message, “TB is Curable – Early Detection and Complete Treatment is the Best Protection,” she emphasized the importance of building a well-informed and compassionate society.

The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, along with Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Advisor Dr. Habibullah Khan, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.

**Outcome:**

The outcome of the program was positive as villagers gained important awareness about TB symptoms, prevention, and treatment. They learned the value of early diagnosis, proper hygiene, and completing full medical treatment to prevent the spread of tuberculosis. The initiative also helped reduce fear and stigma associated with TB patients. Overall, the program promoted better public health awareness and encouraged progress toward a TB-free community.

The program has a positive impact on society by increasing awareness about tuberculosis prevention, early detection, and proper treatment. 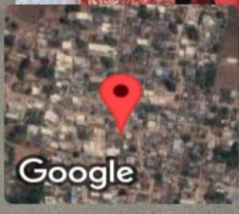

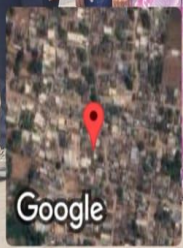
